PURPOSE OF MEDICATION

Expected Pharmacological Action

- Blocking both cell death and pathological makeover of the outer-membrane of the cardiac cells

Therapeutic Use

- Chronic heart failure in adults

Complications

Contraindications/Precautions

- Hypersensitivity, hereditary angioedema
- concuerent use of ACE inhibitors
- Severe hepatic impairment

Interactions

- NSAIDs
- Antihypertensives
- concurrent use of potassium-sparing diuretics
- ACE inhibitors
