1. How many new HIV infections were diagnosed in Erie County during 2022? For Erie County in 2022 it was not calculated because case counts less than 5 are not calculated due to unstable rates
2. How many total new HIV infections were diagnosed in Ohio during 2022?
 - a. Total # of cases: 866
 - b. # of male cases: 676 or 78%
 - c. # of female cases: 190 or 22%
3. What 6 counties in Ohio had the **most** new HIV infections diagnosed during 2022? Include the # of cases for each county. The 6 counties in Ohio with the most new infections are Franklin County (14.8 Rate), Hamilton County (11.5 rate), Mahoning County (11.1 rate), Lawrence County (10.6 rate), Montgomery County (9.9 rate), Cuyahoga County (9.7 rate)
