Drug	Symptoms of Use	Symptoms of Intoxication	Symptoms of Withdrawal
CNS Depressants Examples: Alcohol	Relaxation, loss of inhibition, lack of concentration, drowsiness, slurred speech, sleep	Aggressiveness, impaired judgement, impaired attention, irritability, euphoria, depression	Tremors, nausea/vomiting, malaise, weakness, tachycardia, sweating, elevated blood pressure, anxiety, depressed mood, irritability, hallucinations, headache, insomnia, seizures
CNS Stimulants Examples: Amphetamines and related drugs	Hyperactivity, agitation, euphoria, insomnia, loss of appetite	Fighting, grandiosity, hypervigilance, psychomotor agitation, impaired judgment, tachycardia, pupil dilation	Anxiety, depressed mood, irritability, craving for the substance, fatigue, insomnia, or hypersomnia, psychomotor agitation, paranoid, and suicidal ideation
Opioids Examples: Heroin, morphine, dilaudid	Euphoria, lethargy, drowsiness, lack of motivation, constricted pupils	Euphoria, lethargy, somnolence, apathy, dysphoria, impaired judgment, pupil constriction, drowsiness, slurred speech	Restlessness, body aches, nausea, vomiting, runny nose, watery eyes, poor attention, and concentration, mood changes, tremors, panic attacks, seizures
Hallucinogens Examples: LSD, PCP, Mescaline	Visual hallucinations, disorientation, confusion, paranoid delusions, euphoria, anxiety, panic, increased pulse	Marked anxiety or depression, ideas of reference of delusional thinking that all activity within one’s environment, fear of losing ones mind,	There are no development of physical addiction or withdrawal symptoms

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		paranoid ideation, and impaired judgement	
Cannabinols Examples: Cannabis, Hashish	Relaxation, talkativeness, lowered inhibitors, euphoria, mood swings	Euphoria, anxiety, suspiciousness, sensation of slowed time, impaired judgement, social withdrawal, tachycardia	Restlessness, irritability, insomnia, loss of appetite, depressed mood, tremors, fever, chills, headache, stomach pain
Inhalants Examples:	Dizziness, ataxia, euphoria, excitation, disinhibition, nystagmus, blurred vision, double vision, slurred speech, hypoactive reflexes, lethargy, stupor, or coma	Belligerence, assaultiveness, apathy, impaired judgement, dizziness, slurred speech	Restlessness. Body aches, nausea, vomiting, runny nose, watery eyes, poor attention
