<b>CNS Depressants</b> Examples: alcohol, barbiturates and nonbarbiturates	Relaxation, loss of inhibitions, lack of concentration, drowsiness, slurred speech, sleep	Aggressiveness, impaired judgement, irritability, depression, slurred speech, incoordination, unsteady gait, flushed face	Tremors, nausea/vomiting, malaise, weakness, tachycardia, sweating, elevated blood pressure, anxiety, depressed mood, irritability, hallucinations, headache, insomnia
<b>CNS Stimulants</b> Examples: amphetamines, cocaine, synthetic stimulants	Hyperactivity, agitation, insomnia, restlessness, increased pulse, chest pains	Fighting grandiosity, hypervigilance, psychomotor agitation, impaired judgement, tachycardia, elevated blood pressure, perspiration or chills	Anxiety, depressed mood, irritability, craving for substance, fatigue, insomnia, paranoid, suicidal ideation, social withdrawal
<b>Opioids</b> Examples: heroin, morphine, codeine, dilaudid, etc.	Euphoria, lethargy, drowsiness, lack of motivation, constricted pupils	Euphoria, lethargy, somnolence, apathy, dysphoria, impaired judgement, drowsiness, slurred speech, constipation, nausea, decreased respiratory rate and blood pressure	Craving for drug, nausea, vomiting, muscle aches, pupil dilation, sweating, diarrhea, yawning, fever, insomnia
<b>Hallucinogens</b> Examples: LSD, PCP, ketamine, mescaline, etc.	Visual hallucinations, disorientation, confusion, paranoid delusions, euphoria, anxiety, panic, increased pulse	Belligerence, assaultiveness, impulsiveness, psychomotor agitation, impaired judgement, increased heart rate and blood pressure,	None listed in book

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		diminished pain response, ataxia, muscle rigidity, delirium	
<b>Cannabinols</b> Examples: cannabis, hashish	Relaxation, talkativeness, lowered inhibitions, euphoria, mood swings	Euphoria, anxiety, suspiciousness, sensation of slowed time, impaired judgement, social withdrawal, tachycardia, hallucinations, increased appetite	Restlessness, irritability, insomnia, loss of appetite, depressed mood, tremors, fever, chills, headache, stomach pain
<b>Inhalants</b> Examples: fuels, solvents, adhesives, aerosol propellants, paint thinners	Drowsiness, incoordination, disinhibition, wheezing, dyspnea, pneumonia, abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, unusual breath odor	Belligerence, assaultiveness, apathy, impaired judgement, dizziness, slurred speech, unsteady gait, lethargy, depressed reflexes, tremors, blurred vision, coma, euphoria, irritation of eyes, throat and nose	Restlessness, nausea, vomiting, runny nose, watery eyes, poor attention and concentration, mood changes
