Drug	Symptoms of Use	Symptoms of Intoxication	Symptoms of Withdrawal
<p>CNS Depressants</p> <p>Examples: Benzodiazepines & barbiturates</p>	<p>Relaxation, loss of inhibitions, lack of concentration, drowsiness, slurred speech</p>	<p>Impaired judgement, vomiting, irregular/shallow breathing, memory loss, unconsciousness</p>	<p>Anxiety, agitation, cravings, shaking, insomnia, sweating, high heart rate, BP and temperature, hallucinations, seizures</p>
<p>CNS Stimulants</p> <p>Examples: Amphetamines & cocaine</p>	<p>Hyperactivity, agitation, euphoria, insomnia, loss of appetite</p>	<p>Fighting, grandiosity, hypervigilance, psychomotor agitation, impaired judgement, tachycardia, pupillary dilation, elevated BP, perspiration, chills, nausea and vomiting</p>	<p>Anxiety, depressed mood, irritability, craving for the substance, fatigue, insomnia, hypersomnia, psychomotor agitation, paranoid, suicidal ideation</p>
<p>Opioids</p> <p>Examples: Morphine, codeine & hydrocodone</p>	<p>Euphoria, lethargy, drowsiness, lack of motivation, constricted pupils</p>	<p>Euphoria, lethargy, somnolence, apathy, dysphoria, impaired judgement, pupillary constriction, drowsiness, slurred speech, constipation, nausea, decreased respiratory rate and BP</p>	<p>Drug cravings, nausea, vomiting, muscle aches, lacrimation, rhinorrhea, pupillary dilation, piloerection, sweating, diarrhea, yawning, fever, insomnia</p>
<p>Hallucinogens</p> <p>Examples: LSD, PCP, psilocybin</p>	<p>Visual hallucinations, disorientation, confusion, paranoid delusions,</p>	<p>Belligerence, assaultiveness, impulsiveness,</p>	<p>Anxiety, depression, confusion, irritability, lack of motivation</p>

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	euphoria, anxiety, panic increased pulse	psychomotor, nystagmus, increased heart rate & BP, diminished pain response, ataxia, dysarthria, muscle rigidity, seizures, hyperacusis, delirium	
Cannabinols Examples: Marijuana, dronabinol, Marinol, nabilone, Sativex, cesamet	Relaxation, talkativeness, lowered inhibitions, euphoria, mood swings	Euphoria, anxiety, suspiciousness, sensation of slowed time, impaired judgement, social withdraw, tachycardia, conjunctival redness, increased appetite, hallucinations	Restlessness, irritability, insomnia, loss of appetite
Inhalants Examples: gasoline, varnish remover, lighter fluid	Chemical odor on breath or clothes, stains on hands, behavior changes, decreased appetite, weight loss, slurred speech, runny nose, nosebleeds, tiredness, ulcers on nose or mouth	Belligerence, assaultiveness, apathy, impaired judgement, dizziness, nystagmus, slurred speech, unsteady gait, lethargy, depressed reflexes, tremors, blurred vision	Agitation, irritability, headaches, nausea, sweating, tremors, convulsions, abdominal cramping, cravings
