<b>CNS Depressants</b>  Examples:	Relaxation, loss of inhibitions, lack of concentration, drowsiness, slurred speech, and sleep	Nausea, vomiting, shallow respirations, cold and clammy skin, weak/rapid pulse, coma, possible death, anxiety, fever, agitation, hallucinations, disorientations, tremors, delirium, convulsions, and possible death.	Tremors, nausea/vomiting, malaise, weakness, tachycardia, sweating, elevated blood pressure, anxiety, depressed mood, irritability, hallucinations, headache, insomnia , seizures
<b>CNS Stimulants</b>  Examples:	Hyperactivity, agitation, euphoria, insomnia, loss of appetite, restlessness, talkativeness, increased pulse, dilated pupils, rhinitis, irritability, dizziness, decreased ability to think clearly, increased heart rate, chest pain	Cardiac arrhythmias, headache, convulsions, hypertension, rapid heart rate, coma, possible death, hallucinations, pulmonary edema, respiratory failure, cardiac arrest, increased heartrate, increased blood pressure, nosebleeds, aggressive behavior	Headache, anxiety, depressed mood, irritability, craving for the substance, fatigue, insomnia, hypersomnia, psychomotor agitation paranoid/suicidal ideations
<b>Opioids</b>  Examples:	Euphoria, lethargy, drowsiness, lack of motivation, constricted	Shallow breathing, slowed pulse, clammy skin, pulmonary edema, respiratory arrest,	Craving for the drug, nausea and vomiting, muscle aches, lacrimation, rhinorrhea,

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	pupils	convulsions, coma, possible death.	pupillary dilation, piloerection, sweating, diarrhea, yawning, fever, insomnia
<b>Hallucinogens</b> Examples:	Visual hallucinations, disorientation, confusion, paranoid delusions, euphoria, anxiety, panic, increased pulse	Agitation, extreme hyperactivity, violence, hallucinations, psychosis, convulsions, possible death	Craving of the drug, anxiety, depression, confusion, irritability, and lack of motivation
<b>Cannabinols</b> Examples:	Relaxation, talkativeness, lowered inhibitions, euphoria, mood swings	Fatigue, paranoia, delusions, hallucinations, possible psychosis	Irritability, anger or aggression, nervousness, restlessness or anxiety, sleep difficulty, decreased appetite or weight loss, depressed mood, abdominal pain, tremors, sweating, fever, chills, or headache
<b>Inhalants</b> Examples:	Rapid excitation, drowsiness, incoordination, disinhibitions,	Belligerence, assertiveness, apathy, impaired judgment, dizziness, nystagmus, slurred speech, unsteady gait, lethargy depressed reflexes, tremor, blurred vision, stupor or coma, euphoria, irritation around eyes, throat, and nose.	Restlessness, nausea and vomiting, runny nose, watery eyes, poor attention/concentration, and mood changes
