CNS Depressants Examples: Barbiturates, Hypnotics, Antianxiety agents, Club drugs	Anxiety Insomnia Sedative effect Lack of concentration	Impaired judgement Impaired Balance Slurred speech	Agitation Tremors Headache Sweating Seizures
CNS Stimulants Examples: Caffeine, Nicotine, bath salts, cloud 9, lightning stardust	Agitation Appetite-Suppression Narcolepsy	Euphoria Anxiety Agitation Impaired judgement	Depression Headaches Fatigue
Opioids Examples: Opium, Codeine, Oxycodone, Fentanyl, smack, Perks	Constipation Hypotension Decreased libido Pupil constriction	Agitation Slurred Speech Impaired Memory Respiratory depression Death	Dysphoric mood N/V Muscle Aches Fever Insomnia
Hallucinogens Examples: Angel Dust, ecstasy, shrooms, Salvia	N/V Increase BP Insomnia Sweating	Anxiety Depression Fearing of losing control	Hallucinogens typically don't lead to withdrawal or physical addiction
