1. What is TeamSTEPPS? TeamSTEPPS is a tool used to provide higher-quality, safer patient care. It is an evidenced-based framework to optimize team performance across the healthcare delivery team.
2. What are the key skills of TeamSTEPPS? Briefly explain each. The key skills include communication, a verbal and nonverbal process by which information can be clearly and accurately exchanged. Team leadership which is the ability to lead teams to maximize the effectiveness of team members by ensuring that team actions are understood. Situation monitoring is the process of actively scanning and assessing situational elements to gain information or understanding. Mutual support which is the ability to anticipate and support team members' needs through accurate knowledge about their responsibilities and workload.
3. What are the responsibilities of an effective team leader? The responsibilities of an effective team leader are organizing the team, identify and articulate clear goals, assign tasks and responsibilities, monitor and modify the plan, review the team's performance, manage and allocate resources, facilitate information sharing, encourage teamwork, foster and learning and psychologically safe environment, keep conflict healthy, reinforce patient-centeredness, and model effective teamwork.
