**1. Describe your outstanding personality characteristics (relevant to nursing) possessed at the completion of the program:**

My communication skills have greatly improved throughout the nursing program. I have learned SBAR, how to communicate important changes in patient conditions, and therapeutic communication techniques. I feel more confident in communicating with other health care workers and with patients in establishing a connection and obtaining assessment information.

My teamwork skills have also greatly improved. Through simulation experiences, I learned to work with my peers to provide comprehensive care to the patient in the scenario. Outside the simulation room, I have worked with nursing staff to assess and implement patient care.

**2. Describe your special interests and abilities in nursing:**

I enjoy ensuring quality and safe nursing practice by keeping up with evidence based practice. I also enjoy looking through documentation to ensure nursing care is complete, timely, and appropriate. I enjoy making connections with patients and seeing their health improve on a daily basis with the implementation of nursing interventions and orders.

**3. Discuss your experiences with interpersonal relationships – faculty and staff, patients and their families, and members of the healthcare team throughout the nursing program:**

During one clinical experience, I was the team leader and one of the student nurses identified that her patient had very low blood pressure and needed to obtain manual readings in bilateral arms. I assisted the student nurse with the blood pressure readings and we worked together to report our findings to the charge nurse and our instructor. We worked with our instructor to implement new orders for the patient and identify reasons for the lowered blood pressure. We were able to provide education to the patient about signs and symptoms of low blood pressure and how we were working to address it.

This example provides an example for my experience with interpersonal relationships throughout the nursing program. I worked with my peers to provide patient care and to report complications and issues to the appropriate personnel (charge nurse and nursing instructor). I was able to work with the instructor to learn about complications experienced and to better understand and make connections between assessment findings, treatment plans, and outcomes. I also have been able to build connections with patients and have provided education so that they can make the best decisions regarding their care.

**4. Participation in activities throughout the program:**

Throughout the program I participated in some volunteer activities through the school of nursing and I participated in student senate, curriculum committee, and student welfare.
