Drug	Symptoms of Use	Symptoms of Intoxication	Symptoms of Withdrawal
CNS Depressants Examples: alcohol	Drowsiness, lack of concentration, slurred speech, and relaxation.	Vomiting, nausea, cool/clammy skin, shallow respirations, and rapid pulse.	Anxiety, sweating, insomnia, agitation, disorientation, hallucinations, and seizures.
CNS Stimulants Examples: Cocaine	Hyperactivity, restlessness, dilated pupils, rapid pulse, talkative, and rhinitis.	Hallucinations, respiratory failure, cardiac arrest, pulmonary edema, and possible death.	Mood swings, paranoia, agitation, sleep disturbances, and cravings.
Opioids Examples: Oxycodone	Lethargy, drowsiness, constricted pupils, and lack of motivation.	Shallow breathing, clammy skin, pulmonary edema, respiratory arrest, convulsions, coma, and possible death.	Restlessness, sweating, pain, medication cravings, difficulty concentrating, low energy, depression, and irritability.
Hallucinogens Examples: PCP	Hallucinations, confusion, paranoid, anxiety, and increased pulse.	Agitation, violence, psychosis, convulsions, possible death, and hyperactivity.	Panic, disorientation, medication cravings, difficulty thinking and speaking, insomnia, tremors, and headaches.
Cannabinols Examples: CBD	Relaxation, mood swings, euphoria, and talkativeness.	Paranoia, fatigue, hallucinations, and psychosis.	Symptom return, headache, irritability, or minimal withdrawal symptoms.

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Inhalants Examples: Spray paints	Impaired judgement, dizziness, slurred speech, impaired gait, tremors, blurred vision, mood changes, and seizures.	Dizziness, euphoria, drowsiness, nausea, vomiting, tremors, watery or red eyes, and coughing.	Mood swings, vomiting, cravings, difficulty concentrating, shaking, lethargy, seizures, and sleep disturbance.
