Drug	Symptoms of Use	Symptoms of Intoxication	Symptoms of Withdrawal
<p>CNS Depressants</p> <p>Examples: Alcohol, barbiturates, (phenobarbital) zolpidem, hypnotics, antianxiety agents (alprazolam)</p>	<p>Relaxation, loss of inhibitions, lack of concentration, drowsiness, slurred speech, sleep.</p>	<p>Aggressiveness, impaired judgement, impaired attention, irritability, incoordination, flushed face, emotional lability.</p>	<p>Tremor, n/v, weakness, sweating, headache, insomnia, seizures, hallucinations.</p>
<p>CNS Stimulants</p> <p>Examples: amphetamines, cocaine, caffeine, nicotine.</p>	<p>Hyperactivity, euphoria, dilated pupils, increased pulse, loss of appetite.</p>	<p>Fighting, grandiosity, perspiration or chills, n/v, hypervigilance, psychomotor agitation.</p>	<p>Anxiety, depressed mood, irritability, cravings for substance, fatigue, insomnia, paranoid, suicidal ideation.</p>
<p>Opioids</p> <p>Examples: opium, codeine, heroin, fentanyl, oxycodone.</p>	<p>Euphoria, lethargy, drowsiness, lack of motivation, constricted pupils.</p>	<p>Euphoria followed by, apathy, dysphoria, impaired judgment. Pupillary constriction, drowsiness, slurred speech, constipation. Severe: Respiratory depression and coma</p>	<p>n/v, muscle aches, lacrimation, sweating, insomnia, piloerection.</p>
<p>Hallucinogens</p> <p>Examples: ketamine, LSD, phencyclidine</p>	<p>Visual hallucinations, disorientation, confusion, paranoid delusions, euphoria, anxiety, panic, increased pulse.</p>	<p>Ideas of reference, anxiety, depersonalization/derealization, belligerence, hypertension.</p>	<p>irritability, anxiety, depression.</p>

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<p>Cannabinols</p> <p>Examples: marijuana, hashish.</p>	<p>Relaxation, talkativeness, lowered inhibitions, euphoria, mood swings.</p>	<p>Conjunctival injection, increased appetite, dry mouth, tachycardia, impaired level of consciousness.</p>	<p>Irritability, anxiety, sleep difficulty, decreased appetite, abdominal pain, tremor, sweating fever, chills, or headache.</p>
<p>Inhalants</p> <p>Examples: nitrous oxide, amyl nitrites, toluene</p>	<p>Rapid excitation followed by drowsiness, incoordination, and disinhibition. Unusual breath odors.</p>	<p>Dizziness, ataxia, euphoria, slurred speech, coma, nystagmus, psychomotor retardation, hypoactive reflexes.</p>	<p>Restlessness, n/v, runny nose, watery eyes, poor attention, and poor concentration.</p>
