Drug	Symptoms of Use	Symptoms of Intoxication	Symptoms of Withdrawal
CNS Depressants Examples: alcohol	Relaxation, loss of inhibitions, lack of concentration, drowsiness, slurred speech, sleep	Aggressiveness, impaired judgment, impaired attention, irritability, depression, slurred speech, unsteady gait	Tremors, N/V, malaise, weakness, tachycardia, sweating, elevated BP, anxiety, depressed mood, headache, insomnia, seizures
CNS Stimulants Examples: cocaine	Euphoria, hyperactivity, restlessness, talkativeness, increase pulse, dilated pupils, rhinitis	Euphoria, fighting, hypervigilance, psychomotor agitation, impaired judgment, tachycardia, elevated BP, chills, delirium	Depression, anxiety, irritability fatigue, insomnia, psychomotor agitation, paranoid or suicidal ideation, apathy, social withdrawal
Opioids Examples: Heroin	Euphoria, lethargy, drowsiness, lack of motivation, constricted pupils	Euphoria, lethargy, somnolence, apathy, impaired judgement, drowsiness, slurred speech, constipation, decreased respiratory rate and BP	Craving, drug, N/V, muscles aches, lacrimation, pupillary dilation, sweating, diarrhea, yawning, fever, insomnia
Hallucinogens Examples: ecstasy	Visual hallucinations, disorientation, confusion, paranoid delusions, euphoria, anxiety, panic increase pulse	Belligerence, assaultiveness, impulsiveness, psychomotor agitation, seizures,	

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Cannabinols Examples: marijuana	Relaxation, talkativeness, lowered inhibitions, euphoria, mood swings	Euphoria, anxiety, suspiciousness, sensation slow time, impaired judgment, social withdrawal, tachycardia, conjunctival redness, increase appetite, hallucinations	Restlessness, irritability, insomnia, loss of appetite, depressed mood, tremors, fever, chills, headache, stomach pain.
Inhalants Examples: gasoline		Belligerence, assaultiveness, apathy, impaired judgment, dizziness, nystagmus, slurred speech, unsteady gait, lethargy, depressed, reflexes, tremor, blurred vision, coma, irritation throat, eyes, and nose
