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Apical- Easily accessible site used to assess pulse in children.

Brachial- Site used to assess status of circulation to lower arm and to auscultate blood pressure.

Radial- Common site used to assess character of pulse peripherally and status of circulation to hand.

Ulnar- Site used to assess status of circulation to hand; also used to perform an Allen's test.

Temporal- Easily accessible site used to assess pulse in children.

Femoral-Site used to assess character of pulse during physiological shock or cardiac arrest when other pulses are not palpable; used to assess status of circulation to leg.

Popliteal- Site used to assess status of circulation to lower leg.

Carotid- Easily accessible site used during physiological shock, cardiac arrest, or when other sites are not palpable.

Dorsalis pedis- Site used to assess status of circulation to foot.

Posterior Tibial- Site used to assess status of circulation to foot.
