ASSIGNMENT

Your assigned group will be caring for a patient who was admitted to the hospital and diagnosed with the assigned shock.

1. Assign your patient a name.
2. Complete the following information regarding the type of shock assigned to your group (example: cardiogenic shock).

Symptom(s)
Medical Treatment
Pertinent medication (s)
Pertinent Lab value (s)
Nursing Management
Patient education

Use your textbook, unbound and other current, reliable resources to look up your information.
Please cite the sources used.

3. Create a picture or visual image of what your patient would look like. You may want to include pictures of hospital items which may be used for your patient i.e. Foley bag, IV pump etc. You may choose to draw pictures, use pictures from magazines etc. I encourage creativity!
4. Write (type) your patient's story based on your assigned type of shock.
5. You will post your written story to the "shock" dropbox by 0800 on 03/25/2019. Only one member of the group needs to post for the entire group. Be sure that each group member's name is on the assignment prior to posting.
6. You will share your presentation in class as a group on 03/25/2019.
