### **Learn to CUS short answer question**

C: "Hi doctor I have a concern about the stat order of Lorazepam."

U: "I am uncomfortable giving this child a dose that exceeds the maximum dose for her age."

S: "We have a safety issue; I will give the child a safe dose for her age."

### **Labs and diagnostics short answer question**

1. Carbamazepine- 10-35mg/kg (titrating doses)
2. Diazepam- 2-10 mg/kg
3. Phenobarbital- 3-5mg/kg for infants, 5-8mg/kg for young children, and 8-10mg/kg for older children
4. Phenytoin- 0-2mg/kg
5. Valproic acid- 10-60mg/kg (titrating doses)
6. Primidone- 15-20mg/kg at bedtime
