Noticing	Identify all abnormal assessment findings	3	-	-	Excellent job identifying all abnormal assessment findings. You would not want to include the assessment finding of capillary refill less than 3 seconds. This is a normal finding. However, if it were greater than 3 seconds then it would be considered an abnormal finding.
	Identify all abnormal lab finds/diagnostic tests	3	-	-	All abnormal lab findings/diagnostic tests identified. Great job!
	Identify all risk factors	3	-	-	All appropriate risk factors associated with patient identified.
	Highlight all related/relevant data in the noticing boxes	3	-	-	Excellent job clustering all the relevant data together. For risk factors, you would also want to include the patient's history of a stroke with right sided weakness in your clustered data as well.
Interpreting	List all nursing priorities	3	-	-	Great job listing all the appropriate nursing priorities for the patient.
	Highlight the top nursing priority	3	-	-	Excellent job! The patient's priority problem is Impaired Skin Integrity.
	Identify all potential complications	-	-	1	A potential complication for this patient is infection, however, more specifically potential complications could include sepsis, osteomyelitis, and dehydration.
	Highlight potential complications relevant to top nursing priority	3	-	-	Correctly identified potential complication relevant to top nursing priority.
	Identify signs and symptoms to monitor for each complication	3	-	-	Identified signs and symptoms to monitor for potential complication of infection.
Responding	List all nursing interventions relevant to top nursing priority	3	-	-	Excellent job! Greater than 75% of all nursing interventions included. Along with the wound assessment, you should also include a skin assessment as well. An intervention related to monitoring the patient's blood glucose levels would be important as well. Don't forget about a pain assessment also.
	Interventions are prioritized	3	-	-	Excellent job prioritizing your nursing interventions.
	All interventions include a frequency	-	2	-	Great job! 5 out of 8 interventions included a frequency. Remember to include a frequency for all of your nursing interventions.

	All interventions are individualized and realistic	3	-	-	All interventions realistic and individualized based on patient's nursing priority and needs. Great job!
	An appropriate rationale is included for each intervention	3	-	-	Excellent job! For your wound assessment intervention, be sure that you include more specific information in the rationale related to what you are assessing. For example, drainage, color, odor, etc. All other rationales were appropriate.
