Noticing	Identify all abnormal assessment findings	3	-	-	Excellent job identifying all abnormal assessment findings.
	Identify all abnormal lab finds/diagnostic tests	3	-	-	All abnormal lab findings/diagnostic tests identified. Great job!
	Identify all risk factors	3	-	-	Great job identifying appropriate risk factors. You would want to include the patient’s history of a stroke with right sided weakness as well.
	Highlight all related/relevant data in the noticing boxes	3	-	-	Excellent job clustering all the relevant data together. You should also consider including incontinence in your clustered data as well.
Interpreting	List all nursing priorities	3	-	-	Great job listing all the appropriate nursing priorities for the patient.
	Highlight the top nursing priority	-	-	1	2 points deducted for not selecting the highest nursing priority. While all the priorities you have highlighted are very important, you need to determine which one is your highest priority in that you will attend to this problem first.
	Identify all potential complications	3	-	-	Greater than 75% of potential complications identified. You would also want to include dehydration. You could consider adding osteomyelitis as well.
	Highlight potential complications relevant to top nursing priority	3	-	-	
	Identify signs and symptoms to monitor for each complication	3	-	-	Great job!
Responding	List all nursing interventions relevant to top nursing priority	-	2	-	Excellent job! You would also want to include a skin assessment in addition to your wound assessment to monitor skin turgor. You would also want to include an intervention related to diet education, as well as turning the patient at least every 2 hours to prevent further skin break down. Don’t forget about a pain assessment for the patient as well.

	Interventions are prioritized	-	2	-	Remember to always prioritize your assessments first, followed by medication administration, and then education. You would want to prioritize your wound assessment and medication administration higher than what it is currently. I would recommend making the wound assessment number two, and the medication administration number three on your list.

	All interventions are individualized and realistic	3	-	-	Interventions individualized and realistic for patient.
	An appropriate rationale is included for each intervention	3	-	-	Great job! Rationales are all appropriate. I would also include monitoring the heart rate within your rationales for vital signs as well.
