			SIDE EFFECTS	TEACHING & INTERVENTIONS
Prilosec / Omeprazole	Proton Pump Inhibitor	Increases gastric pH reduces gastric acid production	H/A, pancreatitis, hepatotoxicity, interstitial nephritis	Report H/A. Swallow capsules whole do not chew or crush. Take before eating. Abdominal pain; black tarry stools report
Albuterol Sulfate / Alb Neb.	Sympathomimetic (Adrenergic) Agent	Relaxes smooth muscles - bronchodilation	Bronchospasms, tremors H/A, insomnia	Use IOT if using other inhalers. 5 minute elapse between Rinse mouth with water after use.
Atrivent Neb / Ipratropium Bromide	Antimuscarinics / Antispasmodics	Bronchodilation	Dizziness, H/A, Bronchospasms	DO NOT DOUBLE DOSES PULMONARY FUNCTION NEEDED TO DETERMINE EFFECTIVENESS
Albuminar - 25 / Albumin Human	Blood derivative Volume expanders	Provides colloidal oncotic pressure	Pulmonary edema tachycardia	Explain purpose of solution. Report S/S of hypersensitivity
Phoslo 667 / Calcium acetate	Mineral Replacement preparation	Binds to dietary phosphate and decreases serum phosphorus	Arrhythmias Hypercalcemia Headache	Take on a regular schedule. Avoid taking calcium supplements or antacids
Dextrose / Glucose (IV)	CALORIC SOURCE	Provides calories	Glycosuria Hyperglycemia Local pain at IV site	Correct method of self blood glucose monitoring
Glucose 45 / Glucose	Replacement preparation	Prevention/treatment of hypoglycemia	Fluid Overload Hypokalemia	Advise pt. on when/how to administer for hypoglycemia
