Client Medication Profile worksheet

Medication Classification: Quetiapine 50mg $\frac{1}{2}$ at bedtime

Expected Pharmacological Action (s): Serves as an antagonist of dopamine + serotonin

Therapeutic Use: decreased manifestations of psychoses, depression, or mania

Side/Adverse Effects	Medications/Food Interactions
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• neuroleptic malignant syndrome• seizures• dizziness• weight gain• cognitive impairment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Concurrent use of macrolide anti-infectives \uparrow risk of ventricular arrhythmias.• CNS depression ~ alcohol• Phenytoin \uparrow clearance and \downarrow effectiveness of Quetiapine

Nursing Interventions	Client Education
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• monitor mental status• Assess for suicidal tendencies• Assess weight, BMI, BP• Monitor for tardive dyskinesia	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Take meds as directed• Inform of extrapyramidal symptoms• Change positions slowly to minimize ortho HTN
