Experiences will vary according to the census and scheduled procedures for the day. Make sure to read the radiology packet prior to your experience; take the radiology pre-test and print the skills list to take with you. There will be a post-test you will take on clinical.

Special Procedures (8 hours): Students have the opportunity to observe various vascular procedures and experience nursing care pre- and post-procedure. Students work with nursing preceptors.

Following the clinical experience, write to the following questions and submit via drop box to J. Reising. Assignment is due by 0800 Friday following your experience.

1. What procedures were you able to observe in the Special Procedures area? Explain about the tests.
2. Prioritize key nursing interventions for patients receiving these procedures; give specific examples and why.
3. Critique information about vascular or cardiac function obtained through the various procedures/diagnostic studies in relation to patient symptoms and assessment.
4. What patient teaching or discharge instructions were included along with the testing?
