Greeting Time: <hr/> Morning Transition: <hr/> Morning Meet: Message Board:	<p>Ms. Handy-Pick-up/ greet students as they come, help children sign-in, emotion chart, wash hands. Ms. Lidia (same) LL, SE</p> <hr/> <p>Ms. Lidia: Will work with children after arrival. They will choose a busy bag (materials), book or writing, and work until the morning meeting . We will sing transition song: Come to the carpet PD, LL, SE</p> <hr/> <p>Ms. Handy:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Talking about their emotion (emotion chart) song 2. Who is present/absent (counting) Song 3. What is the weather? Song LL, SE, M and ST <p>Song : Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star, ABC Song, Humpty Dumpty, One, Two, Buckle my Shoe, Itsy Bitsy Spider.</p> <p>Children will choose three out of the five song cards to use.</p> <p>Transition: singing/movement- Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear Touch the Ground, when they move to their planning tables.</p>

Breakfast: Ms. Lidia will help set the table with the classroom helper, and Ms. Handy will help the children wash their hands. Hold conversation with children about what they are eating etc. AL, SE, LL, M

Small Group: Ms. Handy

Activity: Sorting colored cups (red, green, yellow, blue), give the children a basket with the colored cups. Last week I noticed that several of you have been sorting materials during the Arrival Time at the STEM table, so today we will explore some sorting materials. Ask them, "I wonder what you can do with these colored cups." Back up: Counting bears LL, M

Small Group: Ms. Lidia

Activity: Exploring photos cards of various things going on in the environment . I noticed some of you have been looking at the pictures on the wall and talking about what is going on in the pictures. There are some photos in your container that you can look at and discuss what to see and what those photos might mean to you. LL, SE

Large Group: Ms. Lidia will conduct the activity

Activity: Going on a bear hunt. Props: sheet over the small table with a bear inside.

Ms. L- will start off with the song "Going on a Bear Hunt", as children finish putting away their S. G materials and coming to the carpet (Ms. H-will assist),and join with the group as well. We will sing the song and do the motions as we march around the class, and will conclude the activity by finding the bear in the cave and going back to the carpet with the bear. PD, CA

Transition: We will to 'cool/calm down' by meditating/breathing for 3 minutes, by listening to Yoga World; Reflections by: Sona Jobarteh SE, CA

Planning Time: Ms. Handy

Activity: The children will plan by telling the stuffed animal 'bear' what their plan is for work time. LL, SE, AL

Planning Time: Ms. Lidia

The children will march around to each area chanting "When on a bear hunt, I'm going to work in _____ area, with _____, and get off in the area they want to work at. LL, AL, PD
