Do I have materials in the classroom to support this type of play?	U	What item-related materials would you add? (List at least two ideas.) * place measuring cups in the sand and water table * put a measuring tape and ruler in the wood working area
Are there activities that I could do throughout my daily routine to support this COR Advantage item?	Q	What item-related activities would you add to your lesson plan? (List at least two ideas.) * Ask children to identify the the parts of a book during real aloud time * Use techniques to make read alouds active to engage the children in reading.
