(List at least two ideas.)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Have art materials (ex: crayolas) for hand strength - Dry erase markers - Have a sign-in sheet to practice name writing
Are there activities that I could do throughout my daily routine to support this COR Advantage item?	S. Number and counting	<p>How will you plan to look for the missing item? (List at least two ideas.)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use dot markers and then have them count the dots they made - Read stories or sing songs about counting and numbers (ex: “Five Little Monkeys”)
Could I use language related to the missing COR Advantage item to support children’s learning and development in this area?	O. Alphabetic knowledge	<p>How will you plan to look for the missing item? (List at least two ideas.)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Associate letters with names/objects (ex: “A for Amir.”) - Repeat singing of the alphabet song
