



Things you need to know before beginning the Classroom Coach reliability test:


- You will need the following resources:
 - Classroom Coach Measurement Tool
 - Classroom Coach Scoring Guide
 - Scratch paper and pencil or another way to take notes.
- You have one week to complete both sections of the test.
- You must complete each section in one sitting. You may return later to complete the other section. There are no time limits for completing a section.
- We recommend you complete each section in the order listed.
- Within each section:
 - o To confirm the start of the test click **OK**



- o Once you start the test you will see the questions listed. You must click the word **Answer** under each question to reveal the multiple-choice answers. Choose your answer and click **Save**.



- o Once you have answered all the questions within the section, click on ***Finish Test***.



- You may take each section 2 times in order to achieve a minimum of 80% for each topic. You must pass each topic with at least 80% to achieve reliability.
- The second section is based on video clips. You may watch the videos as many times as needed. You will watch the videos, record your anecdotal evidence for each item, and then score individual rows and provide an

overall score for the Classroom Coach items. Note that the questions for video 1 only refer to video 1 and the questions for video 2 only refer to video 2.

- Once you have completed the Classroom Coach reliability test and passed each section with the minimum required 80%, you will be able to print your certificate. Click on the **Grades** tab at the top of the screen and then click on **My Certificates** in the bar on the left-hand side of the screen.
