

Alphabetic knowledge

1. To help fill in this gap, an idea can be a “clothesline literacy activity.” The letters to the child’s name will be on each clothespin. Children can also have their letter link name tag in front of them, to help identify 2 or more letters in their name, and the sequence of their name. It might also help identifying more letters to the alphabet.
2. Another idea would be tactile alphabet cards be put in the sensory table. By either tracing the letter with their finger, or just recognizing the letter.
