Greeting Time:

Hedaia: greet children and parents at arrival.

Elizabeth: encourage children to switch their pictures from home to school then wash their hands.

LL/SE

Child Message:

1. What is Cinco de Mayo?
2. New sand toys have been added to the sand box because some broke. Lets be more careful with the classroom materials.
3. Who is absent today?

LL/AL

Books:

Both teachers will support the children while choosing and reading books. Teachers will encourage children to handle books with care. Children will be encouraged to retell the story by looking at the pictures in the book.

Large Group Time:

We will sing the “Days of the Week” song and fill out the calendar. We will also sing the “What’s The Weather” song and observe the clouds to see if it will be a sunny, cloudy, raining, etc day. Children will choose a book related to the topic of *insects* from the children’s book shelf and Hedaia will read it aloud.

SE/CA/AL

Planning Time:

Hedaia: Use microphone. Ask children which area they are going to work in and what they will work with in that area. LL/SE/AL

Elizabeth: Use the planning board where children will place their picture on the area they will play in. LL/SE/AL/PD

Work Time:

Both teachers will rotate which children and areas they are working in. Collect for anecdotes. Encourage working in math area.

M/LL/SE

Clean-up:

Announce there's 5 minutes left and set the class timer. When timer goes off it's a signal for children to freeze. Sing the clean-up song for children to stop and clean up their work. Help children if needed. Praise children for doing a great job.

M/AL/PD

Recall Time:

Hedaia: "What area did you play in today?" "Who did you play with and what did you do together?" "What was your favorite part about today?" AL/CA/LL

Elizabeth: Provides children with their writing journal and asks them to write down or draw what they did today. AL/PD

Snack: Fruit cups and yogurt.

Books:

Hedaia: The Very Hungry Caterpillar by Eric Carle

Elizabeth: The Best Bug Parade by Stuart J. Murphy

LL/PD

Small group time:

Hedaia: In a group of 5, we will go to school playground to discover different types of insects. Each child will have a magnifying glass in order to see. Teacher will bring the classroom tablet to take pictures of what the children find to discuss at the end of the week. PD/AL/ST

Elizabeth: Children will do an insect sorting game where they would sort insects on the types that fly, crawl, and wiggle. M/LL/AL/ST

Outside Time:

Children will play racing games, red light green light, monkey bars, hide and seek, and slides. Children will be provided with soft balls as well.
