

## EG 102, Public Speaking

### Introductory Speech

\*You are going to write and present an introductory speech based upon your own academic success. Therefore, your introductory speech will include an introduction, one body paragraph, and a conclusion. Listed below is what you should include in each paragraph of your introductory speech.

**Introduction** – Introduce yourself (i.e. your name, hometown, and classification). Then, reveal what your major/minor is. If you have not declared a major yet, reveal what career field interests you the most. Next, reveal what drew you to your chosen career field. Last, explain what the road to student success means to you and how your success will contribute to society.

**First Body Paragraph** – Define the word *perseverance* in your own words. Then, reveal your first experience of perseverance. Explain how encouraging words have affected and/or influenced your perseverance. Describe how perseverance has allowed you to achieve success. Does perseverance equal graduation to you? Explain your answer.

**Second Body Paragraph** – Reveal what challenges you might face while trying to obtain your degree. Then, explain how you will overcome those challenges. Describe any obstacles that you have already faced while trying to continue a higher education. How can you take full advantage of what Huntsville Bible College has to offer its students to ensure success? Describe your determination to succeed. What will your success story be when you graduate from HBC?

\*Your introductory speech is due **Sunday, September 11, 2022**. The speech itself should be at least seven minutes but no more than twelve minutes. Please make sure you time your speech before you present the final product. If your speech is not at least seven minutes, you will lose points. Likewise, if your speech is more than twelve minutes, you will lose points. Also, please make sure that you use correct grammar (i.e. complete sentences) when you are presenting your speech. Below is a rubric that I will use for your introductory speech presentations. However, you may use what you have written, for you do NOT have to memorize your speech, but please use eye contact during your speech. When you present your introductory speech, choose a quiet place where extraneous noise is blocked out. Be creative and innovative! Last, please submit both your visual speech presentation and written presentation in its respective Dropbox in Edvance 360.
