1.QUESTION: HBC IS ACCREDITED THROUGH WHAT AGENCY?

ANS: The Commission on Accreditation of the Association for Biblical Higher Education

2.QUESTION: What type of degrees or certificates does HBC offer ?

ANS: 1. Certificates in Biblical Studies and Church Ministry 2.Degrees: Associate of Arts: Business Management, Information Technology, Christian Education, Missions and Evangelism, Pastoral Ministry, and Christian Education/Child Development. Bachelor of Arts: Pastoral Ministry , Mission and Evangelism, Social Work, and Christian Education. Master of Ministry: Biblical Leadership, Pastoral Ministry. Doctor of Ministry: Biblical Leadership.

3. QUESTION: What are the four institutional goals of HBC?

ANS. 1. To Provide a Comprehensive Educational System. 2. To Provide an Educational Environment. 3.To Provide An Educational Opportunity. 4. To Provide Educational Resources.

4. QUESTION: What are the five admission requirements of HBC ?

ANS. 1. High School diploma or GED (official transcript required) 2. Application for Admission with 35.00 non-refundable fee 3. Student Recommendation Form 4. HBC Statement of Faith Acknowledgement 5. Placement Testing (as required).

5. QUESTION: Explain the Federal Financial Aid Advance Policy:

Students who are facing a financial emergency may request a financial aid advance on any expected grant or loan payouts. If a student has Grant or Loan money forthcoming and will have a credit balance after all tuition, fees and books have been paid, the college may provide an emergency financial advance on that balance to be used for unexpected expenses. Financial aid advances may not be given until after the end of the drop and add period. The most common situations that may lead to a student's eligibility for emergency financial aid include: 1. A sudden health emergency 2. Unexpected loss of income 3. Death in the family, or other family emergency 4. Rent in arrears, and risk of eviction 5. Natural disaster.

6. QUESTION: What are the conditions for dual enrollments for under graduates?

ANS: 1 The student is in the final year of their undergraduate degree program; with less than 12 hours to complete before graduation. 2. The student has met with their advisor and received permission to apply for graduation [all requirements for completing their current undergraduate academic program will be satisfied prior to graduation date.] 3. The student has a GPA OF 3.0 OR above. 4. The student has met with the Dean of Graduate Studies and received their approval to register for graduate courses.
