

Passage: Colossians 1:14

Central Idea: New Testament presents Jesus' death on the cross as a redemptive act for the world as a ransom for many. Paul expresses in This verse that our salvation consists of redemption and forgiveness. Sin sold us out, and therefore it also deprived us. If we are to be redeemed, God must save us from sin through forgiveness by the blood of Christ, which he had shed on the cross.
