

EG 102, Public Speaking Process Speech

* A concept is an idea or theory. When people formulate an idea, it is conceptualized into something that usually benefits other constituents in society. However, many concepts have become taboo within certain realms of society. Therefore, you are going to choose **ONE** topic below and explain the importance of a concept and how it is useful in society and then present it as a process speech. Choose a topic that best interests you and/or one that is personal to you. If you are not familiar with a topic, please do not choose it. Meanwhile, your process speech will include an introduction, two body paragraphs, and a conclusion. Each paragraph should have at least seven sentences. When you develop your speech, make sure that you use an attention-getter to introduce your topic, and make sure you include a thesis statement toward the end of your introduction then reaffirm the thesis statement in your conclusion.

- **Explain the concept of a revolution among social and/or cultural groups.**
- **Explain the concept of political correctness at the local level of government.**
- **Explain the importance of getting the suggested eight hours of sleep at night.**
- **Explain the importance of having a positive attitude.**
- **Explain the difference between the concepts of love and infatuation.**
- **Explain the concept of social justice and/or social injustice.**
- **Explain the different concepts among communications media.**
- **Explain the importance of art programs in public education.**
- **Explain the importance of music education as it relates to children who have learning and/or physical disabilities.**
- **Explain the concept of feminism as it relates to the workplace.**
- **Explain the importance of mental health and how it benefits physical health.**
- **Explain the importance of time management and how it affects professionalism.**
- **Explain the concept of financial literacy and why it is detrimental to financial freedom.**
- **Explain the importance of having math, reading, and writing skills.**
- **Explain the concept of artistic expression.**

*Your written process speech is due **Sunday, October 16, 2022, by 11:59 p.m.** However, your audiovisual (i.e. your recording of yourself) speech is due **Wednesday, October 19, 2022 by 5:00 p.m.** The speech itself should be between seven to ten minutes. Please make sure you time your speech before you present the final product. If your speech is not at least seven minutes, you will lose points. Likewise, if your speech is more than ten minutes, you will lose points. Also, please make sure that you use correct grammar (i.e. complete sentences) when you are presenting your speech. Below is a rubric that I will use for your process speech presentation. Meanwhile, you may use what you have written, for you do NOT have to memorize your speech, but please use eye contact during your speech. You are encouraged but not required to use visual aids during your process speech. When you present your process speech, choose a quiet place where extraneous noise is blocked out. Also, please make sure that you are dressed appropriately and professionally. Meanwhile, be creative and innovative! If you plagiarize, you will earn an automatic zero. Your speech **MUST** be original.
