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Orientation To College

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Define and give examples of active listening. Active listening is the practice of preparing to listen, observing what verbal and non-verbal messages are being sent, and then providing appropriate feedback.

Define and give examples of inactive listening. Inactive listening is the opposite of Active Listening. It shows that one probably doesn't know (or care about) what the speaker is saying and makes it harder to connect to the speaker. Solution messages should also be avoided in responses.

Define and give examples of the read/write learning style. Read/write learners learn primarily by reading and writing. They prefer to learn information by reading notes, handouts, and textbooks. These learners make use of dictionaries and other

reference materials. They also benefit by rewriting notes and rereading notes  
silently again and again.

Define distress and give three examples. Emotional, social, spiritual, or physical  
pain or suffering,

Define eustress and give three examples. Public Speaking, Buying a new house,

Explain the Cornell notetaking system. The Cornell Note Taking method  
discourages the use of long sentences. It is about short notes that you write down in  
the right-hand column using recognizable abbreviations and symbols. Prior to the  
note taking, draw up a list of abbreviations and expressions. This makes the note-  
taking process even easier.
