

## Public Speaking/EG 102

### Final Exam

\* The speeches that you presented during the semester included introductory, process, event, cause and effect, and question on policy. Therefore, you are going to write a three-paragraph essay based upon the speeches that you have presented this semester. Thus, you will include an introduction, one body paragraph, and a conclusion. Each paragraph should have at least seven sentences but no more than ten sentences. Below is what you should include in each paragraph.

**Introduction:** Introduce yourself, and include where you reside (i.e. your hometown). Next, reveal the reason why you took the class. Was Public Speaking/EG 102 required for your program of study, and/or did you want to advance your public speaking skills? Explain your answer. Then, reveal whom your favorite public speaker(s) is/are and why. Have you always enjoyed said public speaker(s)? Explain your answer. Last, reveal how public speaking plays a pivotal role in your personal and/or professional life.

**Body Paragraph:** Has public speaking always been natural to/for you? Explain your answer. What challenges have you faced when speaking publicly? How do you adapt to an environment when speaking publicly? How important is your audience when you speak publicly? How do you engage your audience when you speak publicly? How do you respond to your audience if they are not responsive and/or seem uninterested with the content of your speech? How do you adjust?

**Conclusion:** How did you prepare for the very first speech (i.e. the introductory speech)? After you presented the very first speech, did you consider the feedback from the instructor to prepare for the next speech? Explain your answer. How has the feedback from the instructor helped you to improve upon your delivery? Do you feel more confident about public speaking after taking the course? Explain your answer. How will you continue to sharpen your public speaking skills? How will public speaking enhance your career/desired career? Last, how will public speaking allow you to change the world?

\*Your final exam essay is due on **Sunday, December 11, 2022, by 11:59 p.m.** Your writing assignment must be submitted in proper MLA format. That means that it must be typed in black ink. The font must be Times New Roman or Arial and should be size 12. All lines must be double-spaced. Your last name and the appropriate page number must appear in the upper righthand header of each page. Your name, my name, the class prefix/section number/class number, and the date that the assignment is due must appear in the heading in the upper left-hand corner. There should be a title, centered. If you plagiarize, you will earn a zero.
