Unit Introduction

This second unit continues and completes the teaching of our seven doctrines of salvation. We learned the first five in the first unit. There are two left:

(6) All Man must do to be Saved is Believe

(7) Assurance of Eternal Life.

Knowing that all man must do to be saved is believe is especially important in Christianity today. Almost everyone tries to add something to believing the gospel. Some examples of other things added are repentance, commitment, perseverance, works, baptism, discipleship, and the kitchen sink! Instead we aim to keep the gospel as simple and clear as the Bible does. So we use the biblical language the Bible writers do and the clear verses that promise salvation based solely on believing that Christ died for us.

Eternal security is closely tied to how we are saved and who has saved us. Our God is a great savior; therefore He does not partially save us. He saves us completely and forever. We are kept by Him, the one who has paid it all. He promises eternal life to all who believe and we can trust Him for He cannot lie. As we will see, this doctrine is very practical for how we live the Christian life.

How would you feel if you entered a race, were the only one in the race, diligently ran it and yet did not win it? This happened to Israel. For after the time of Abraham up until the time of Christ, Israel was the one nation chosen out of all the nations of the earth to be God's people. God even called them, and loved them like his son (Hos 11:1).

Yet regarding how to pursue righteousness they made a big mistake. Paul tells us "that the Gentiles, which followed not after righteousness, have attained to righteousness, even the righteousness which is of faith. But Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, hath not attained to the law of righteousness" (Rom 9:30-31). Did you get that? We must be sure we see their mistake. Paul goes on, saying, "Wherefore? Because they sought it not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone" (Rom 9:32). In their race for righteousness, they stumbled over the rock

God laid in Zion, namely Christ. They did not win their race for righteousness because they pursued it as if it was by works. Instead, believing Gentiles who weren't even running after righteousness, received a righteousness that is by faith. You see, "and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed" (Rom 9:33).

I want to go over couple verses. Now you can turn in your Bible some of these are in the verses we have already given out, but in Romans 4:5 to show people it's the next clearest verse of the Bible in my opinion, to show people that you're saved by grace. Romans 4:5, but to him that worketh not I think that's about as clear as you can get, don't you? That to him that worketh not believe upon him to justify the ungodly his faith is counted for righteousness. You see that? Him that worketh not but believeth upon him that justifies the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness. Whenever you're witnessing to people you got to show them over and over until they see it that their righteousness will not get them to Heaven, even as David in verse 6 also describe the blessedness of the man unto whom God imputed righteousness. Do you see that isn't that clear? Saying Blessed are those whose iniquities are forgiven and whose sins are covered. Blessed is the man to whom the Lord will not impute sin. The man or the woman that God will not impute sin is the one that believes that Jesus Christ paid it all and we have no works of all. Don't you like that, but to him that worketh not isn't that about as clear as you can get? but believeth on him the justified the ungodly. There's a lot of people that are working their way to heaven, and they're not gonna get there. AND then there's some people that don't do anything. Now listen, I believe all Christians ought to have works. But there are some Christians that have no works. But if they believe in Christ they are going to go there. You got to make that clear. So important to make that clear I think these verses are so very important to be able to give. Now in that same chapter dropping down to verse 22 of Romans chapter 4, and therefore it was imputed to him for righteousness. Now it was not written for his sake alone that it was imputed to him, but for us also. To whom it shall be imputed if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord, from the dead. If we believe him that raised him from the dead us also be imputed. Do you see the clearness of that? You need to be able to know these verses and you need to be able when someone's really having a hard time, and these are the verses you need to be able to take to these people where they can be able see it.

Romans 9 and Righteousness by Faith

Now over in Romans nine verse 30 that the Gentiles which followed not after righteousness have obtained righteousness even the righteousness which is of faith. In other words it's saying Gentiles and most of us here are Gentiles, but Israel which followed after the law of righteousness hath not obtained the law of righteousness. Wherefore because they sought it, not by faith, in the Old Testament and in the New Testament no one was ever saved except by faith. But as it were by the works of the law for they stumbled at the stumbling stone. What's a stumbling stone? A stumbling stone is when they say I'm gonna work my way to heaven. You say, is it really that wrong preacher when people say they got to do something to get to heaven. Yes it's that wrong. Only when we see it's Christ and it's Christ only. What do we lack? We lack righteousness. God is anxiously waiting to give us his righteousness. God gives his righteousness to who ever accepts Christ's payment for their sin and he gives his righteousness the moment the person accepts it. Here's how you present this. Here's where it is very important since it's the heart of the Gospel you should carefully go over these verses. Christ paid for all sin. If a person does not accept the teachings of Scripture at first, reiterate trying to make the verse is as clear as you possibly can. And of course we're going to talk about the hand gesture and how to do that a little bit later. But you know and you see me give it every Sunday, the hand gesture and why I give the hand gesture. To make the gospel just as clear as possible. You say but God's the one to do the saving and that's right. He saves us through words that we present. How shall they hear if they don't have a preacher? And our words need

to be clear. And this is what's so very important that we do this, it's important that people be able to understand it.

The offer of Christ for salvation is totally free. Christ makes that clear in many verses. For example, Revelation 21:6: "I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely." Another is the well-known offer in John 3:16: "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life".

But how can something so valuable be obtained so freely and easily? It only can be because someone else paid the full cost. So when we look at how easy it is we must consider the whole picture. This beyond value salvation correctly was obtained at a great cost, by Jesus shedding His precious blood (1 Pet 1:19). By Jesus being obedient to death, even the death on the cross (Phil 2:8). But because He paid the full price, He can offer it to us free of charge therefore freely given to those who believe.

Topic 2: Sixth Doctrine of Salvation: All Man Must Do to Be Saved Is Believe

John 3:16 and Believe

Now we're going to look at doctrine number six that we've been presenting. Doctrine number six is all man must do to be saved is believe. Jesus was the Lord who paid for all sin received Christ as his Savior.

God gives eternal life only to those who accept it by faith alone. Believe. It's over and over and over in the gospel of John. It's over and over and over in Acts. Believe, believe, believe. God gives eternal life only to those who will accept it by faith alone. If a person believes that they do not get saved by faith alone they cannot possibly be saved. Now, John 3:16, the most quoted verse in the Bible, I'm afraid it's kinda misunderstood. I really am. For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten son that whosoever believes in him should not perish but have everlasting life. I tell you, you can take this verse and you can win people to Christ with this verse. I like to use this verse by putting people's name in it. I had a man I worked with at Brinks. I decided to start winning this guy to Christ. He didn't have many days left on this earth. Anyway I started on him and witnessing to him and I use this verse right here. And I said Kaiser were you gonna go when you die and he said, well, I don't know. I don't know where I'm going. I said, Kaiser do you believe Jesus Christ paid for all your sins, that He shed his blood and died and rose again? He said, Yes. I said do you believe in him? He said yes. I said where you gonna go when you die? He says, to hell. And so I went and said let me show you this verse. I got my Bible and opened the Bible let me tell you, now don't carry your Bible around don't go around witnessing carrying your Bible. You know why? Don't red flag it. If you're gonna cross the field with a bull in it, you wouldn't start off with a red flag. would you? When you to win someone to Christ, you don't want to turn them off before you can win them. Now it's not a matter of being ashamed. I'm not ashamed of this. As a matter of fact, I'm proud of this Bible. I'm not ashamed I just want to be effective with it. Anyway I got the Bible out and I said for God so loved the world. I said is that you and me, Kaiser. He said that's the world, you and me. That he gave his only begotten son. I said, Kaiser, who is that. He said, it's Jesus. And then I said, that whosoever. I said who is that Kaiser? He said whosoever would be me. I said believeth in him, believeth in whom? He said, Christ. Should not perish. I said perish, Kaiser said it means go to a hell. But have everlasting life. I said, Now Kaiser, do you believe in Jesus Christ? He said, Yes I do. Do you believe he paid for all your sins? He said, yes I do. Do you believe he paid for all of them you don't have to pay for them? He says that's right. I said, you believe in Christ? He said I sure do. I said, where are you going when you die, and he says to hell. Now I literally went over this literally this is not exaggeration 20 times. I said for God so loved the world Kaiser. He said, that's right. That he gave his only begotten son, that's Jesus. He said that's right. That whosoever, he said that's me. Believe in him, I said, do you believe in Him, and he said yes, I do. And it says, should not perish, What does that say, should not perish, then what is does it say? But have everlasting life. He said, that's what it says. I said Do you believe in him? He said yes, I believe in him. Do you have everlasting life? He said, yes I do. And I said so where you going when you die? And he said hell. I went over it again. Make a long story short, one time I went over it and he said, I see it. He said, I see it. He said, I see it. He said, I'm saved now. I said, why do you know? He said, because Christ paid all my sin. I was afraid to ask him I said where are you going when you die and he said, Heaven. And he truly got saved. And you say, it can't be that simple. Yes, it can. That's what it means by grace. That's why I mean stay with them. I'm not saying that's the only way to do it. Those who try to work and earn their eternal life they can't make it. You can only get to heaven by believing

I shared with some of you this, John 6:47, I know I heard this at Bible college. It sounds hokey but John 6:47 will get you to heaven but you'll always remember that verse. A good verse to use. Verily verily I say to you he that believeth upon me hath everlasting life. Listen you can use this to win a person to Christ. It means you have it. Then in John 1:12 as many as received him to them gave he power to become the sons of God even to them that believe on his name. Salvation is always receiving. We do nothing we accept what Christ has done. We receive him as Savior. Boy that's the one thing that I want to do until I die. I to make that gospel clear. Sunday after Sunday oh, I've had my critics but no one's ever criticized me for not preaching the Gospel. I've had my critics over the years but they've never said that I don't give the Gospel. John 6:28,29, and they said then said they unto him, what shall we do that we might work the works of God? And Jesus answered and said to them this is the work of God you may believe on him that sent him. God did the work. God only asked us that we believe on Christ. Boy is that important to be able to do that and see it. See what God has done. Philippians 3:9, and be found in him not having my own righteousness which is of the law, but that which is through faith in Christ's righteousness which is of God by faith. Notice what it says here. It says, found in Christ not in the Pope, not in your church, not in your denomination or your own philosophy. You are found in Christ, not trying to get to heaven by your own righteousness, but by receiving Christ's righteousness. God counts your righteousness because of your faith not because of your works. Now that's what you got to get across. I'm going to go over Ephesians 2:8,9 just a little bit. For by grace, by mercy from God, we get what we don't deserve. There's not one of us in here that deserves to go to heaven. You say, but we're not as bad as some people. It all depends on how you look at what's bad. We don't deserve it. It's just the opposite really Grace is getting the opposite of what you deserve. Are you saved. That means not helped, not instructed but saved. Isn't that a difference? Some people always think that well if I worked long enough, I'll make it. I'll see a good example, No, it doesn't say instructed not helped but saved. True faith, not through your church, not through yourself, not through anything else. Just through your faith. Then it says, that not of yourselves, not by what you do regardless. It's not what you do. How many times to you hear a preacher say, if you don't come forward, you can't be saved. And when there were 5000 saved, it didn't say 5000 raised their hands to be saved, it didn't say 5000 came forward to be saved, it says 5000 what? Believed and were saved. I'm just saying the Bible. You look through the Bible.

God doesn't want any braggarts in heaven. And won't be any braggarts there. There just won't be any there. He doesn't want any of them there. All praise will be to the Lord Jesus Christ. There'll

be no braggarts heaven. There'll be no one in heaven saying Look what I have done. Boy I don't want to go there. Would you live in heaven with some of these obnoxious people down there in this earth? Braggarts. People than just brag and brag and tell you how great they are. When you find a truly great person you find a person who doesn't brag. Now I want to go over Galatians 3 chapter 3 verse 22 through I tell you use these verses and you will be able to win people to Christ. You say I can never win anybody to Christ. Yes you can let some but you will pay price. In Galatians 3:22 but the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe. Everyone is a sinner and God promises to save those who have faith and believe in Christ. Boy I tell you these verses are so important. but before faith came we were Under the law shut into the faith which should afterwards be revealed Before you trusted Christ, you thought salvation was for keeping the law. Now I want us to think on this verse 23 again. Before faith came we were kept under law shut up in the faith which should afterwards be revealed. Here's what I want you to understand. I believe that everyone before they're saved believes they are saved by works. I believe that this verse teaches that I believe this verse teaches that everyone before they're saved believes they're saved by works. That's why grace versus works and that's why it's so important to be able to explain the Gospel. People believe that they are literally actually positively saved by works. That's why so many people reject Christianity. If they can only see the truth of Christianity if they could only see what Christianity really is, if they could only see Christianity is not about some people claim to be but it is just what Jesus did. Oh I tell you, you want them to see true Christianity but they been turned off. That's why I'm telling you, don't red flag it when you witness. That's why I'm telling you, be nice to people and show the Christian principles and when you have tragedy in your life, show people you're gonna stand up. Show people that you really do believe in eternal life and you really do believe that when we lose a good friend that person's in heaven. Let them see that. Verse 24, wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us the Christ that we may be justified by faith, the law showed us how short we came to perfection. So you saw your need of Christ the Savior. The law didn't save you, it let you know how dirty you are. The law's like the mirror and the mirror lets you see how dirty are when you're cleaning yourself up. Christ was what, our schoolmaster. Bring us to Christ. The law only let us see how dirty we are. And the wherefore the law was our schoolmaster that word schoolmaster means truant officer to bring us to Christ that we might be justified by faith. The law showed how short you came of perfection so you saw your need of Christ as Savior. Verse 25. But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster, truant officer, when you trusted Christ by faith the law has served its purpose. Purpose is done away with as far as you are now concerned, then verse 26, for we are the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. You became a child of God for your faith in Christ and he will take care of you.
