## Personal Evangelism

### I. Course Description

Personal Evangelism is an in-depth study of the clear Gospel of grace. The study includes the steps and process one should use in witnessing. Ideas are given regarding how to attain favorable attention and build relationships in witnessing. Different religions and their beliefs are discussed, as well as how the Christian should witness to people who are in them.

- C. Have confidence in sharing the Gospel with people of other beliefs

### III. Course Requirements

- C. **Class work:** The course work consists of recorded lectures and study packs. Opportunities for practical application include answering *Victory in Grace* phones and soul-winning trips to downtown Chicago.
- D. **Bible Study Projects:** none
- E. **Bible Memorization:** There are 116 verses that are required to be memorized throughout the duration of the course. This list is available from the Academic Office and also for download.

### IV. Tests & Grading

Tests are taken at the completion of each unit. There are 14 Units, and 14 Tests. Tests are graded on a percentage basis, and a minimum of 80% is required for a passing grade. If you score less than an 80%, you must repeat the work in the Unit.
