Lesson Introduction

Today's world situation makes prophecy a topic of interest to many people. With Israel back in the land in the Middle East, there will always be news coming out of that part of the world. Since the time of Abraham, her enemies have hated her testimony for God.

Earthquake, tsunamis, hurricanes, and floods among other natural disasters seem to be increasing in number and intensity. Though unbelievers may not understand everything the Bible says, they are aware that the Bible predicts these things for the end times. This raises their level of concern and interest.

Then, once you get their interest and transition into presenting the gospel, you want to close well and invite the person to whom you are speaking to believe. If they do believe, you want them to see God's promise of eternal life from the Bible. If they reject the gospel, you want to warn them of the consequences.

Topic 1: Favorable Attention

This is a reminder to open with favorable attention. Current news topics provide a good way to open. Many of these can be tied in with something unique to Christianity: Bible prophecy.

To witness to a person, you have to have what we believe is favorable attention. That you should give some way to be nice to that person before you just start into something. It is very important that we are able to have a way to open. I think the current news is a tremendous way to be able to open a topic, but

we do want to share with you on opening things up. If you can just use anything to open up the word of God to a person, and to share with them, now the greatest thing I know to share with the person is using our tracts that we have out in the lobby, our heaven tracts, and that's a way to open things up. But I'll tell you today with the topics that are around we can get a discussion of prophecy, and you'll be surprised how many people really want to talk about prophecy right now. It's just incredible, and everybody wants to know about prophecy. You can get into prophecy and you can kind of stay out of politics, you know, the kind of politics that will get people mad at you, but get into prophecy and open things up. Now here's some of the things, just looking at the book of Daniel, just Daniel alone this is real easy if you want to make it easy for yourself kind of mark these verses as we go. This is just kind of a nice easy way to share with somebody prophecy. You see the reason we know the Bible to be the word of God is because it has prophecy. Other religions of the world would not dare to have prophecy. Because they are not true, they are not the word of God, there is only one word of God and that's the Bible and it has prophecy.

Topic 2: Prophecy

Ezekiel 37 contains an amazing piece of prophecy. This chapter is often titled "The Valley of Dry Bones." In Ezekiel's prophecy God takes Ezekiel to a valley full of dry bones (Ezk 37:2-3). Their dryness showed their hopeless condition for future life. But God speaks to the bones and tells them He will give them breath and they will live (Ezk 37:5-6). First they are restored but without breath (Ezk 37:7-8). Then they were given breath and they stood on their feet, a great army of people (Ezk 37:9-10).

God interprets this vision for Israel in the next four verses (Ezk 37:11-14). God, about 2600 years ago, is promising them that they'll return to the land; they will first return in unbelief, but eventually in faith. This prophecy is being fulfilled before our eyes as Israel returned as a nation in 1948.

Topic 2: Prophecy

The Antichrist will Come

Daniel foretells, God foretells in Daniel 7:23, that the last world ruler will devour the whole earth. Now that's quite a statement, now you say what's prophecy about that? Well it says devour the whole earth, it means totally consume this whole earth. In Daniel 8:23 it says the ruler of latter times will use dark sentences. According to the Hebrew it means trickery. He will use trickery. In other words this great world leader is going to come and he's going to trick people into thinking. Now who is he going to trick? Well you know he's going to trick the Jews, he's going to trick the different nations, and he's going to be able to just promise just all kinds of things, he's going to have wild schemes. Now someone will say, how can we use that in prophecy? Well, the Bible says there will be a one world Church, a one world

Government, do you see how that could be happening? Do you see how people are just turning away more and more from Christianity? And more and more to a God quote? How America is turning away from God? 8: 24 tells us, Daniel 8:24 that the great satanic power, the increase of his dominion, and martyrdom of Christians, at his hand. We know that during the tribulation period, that Christians are martyred, by the hundreds of thousands. In verse 25 of Daniel 8 it says, lets us know that his policy is to use craft, that means deceit. His policies should be advanced through deceit. He will think he is very great, but the Lord Jesus eventually will conquer him. But there is this person, we believe that person is already alive, that person will be revealed, that person will will, now no reflection, I'm not trying to reflect on people, but this will be a Ronald Reagan and a John Kennedy and an Abraham Lincoln, and all the great men, and a George Washington, that we could ever put together in one. Now I don't mean a bad thing on those men's character, I just mean this anti-Christ is going to be so professional and so polished that he's going to dupe the world, and the world is being duped right now.

This is, you know the Bible says, Jesus said, when they say, peace, peace, where there is no peace, this is the sign of the last days. This is a good way to witness to people. There has never been one more wicked than this man, and no man. In Daniel 11:24, no man shall have done evil like him before because he will scatter among them the prey. They are going to start promising economic wonderfulness, for every one. See if we could have a New World order, now remember what happened at the Tower of Babel? What were they trying to do? They were trying to have a New World order right? God says multiply go out in the world, they said, no we are going to build a Tower of Babel. They wanted to have a one world Government, a one world order. They're saying look if we don't have to have the Navy and the Army and the Air Forces, and we don't have to have the nuclear weapons, we will have a new world order, and everyone will have it. Let me tell you something, man is to corrupt, you will never be able to have no Army or Navy as long as man is in control. Because you see, the problem with man is that their dishonest, their deceitful, they can't be trusted. In witnessing, it is very important. The Jews in Prophecy

How about using prophecy of the Jews as a conversation opener? I think this is a marvelous thing to be able to use, of the Jews. You know, you just look at the Jewish people, they are an amazement they are the proof. People did not believe they would ever go back and be a nation in 1948. In May 14, 1948, and the Jews became a nation and all the countries are coming against them, and yet God says the Jews will go back to the land. Listen people are saying when it is that rapture going to come? Boy this is a good verse to show to people, Amos 9:14 and 15, and I will bring again the captivity of my people of Israel and they shall build the way cities and inhabit them. They shall plant Vineyards and drink the wine therein. They shall also make gardens, and eat the fruit of them, and I will plant them upon their land and they shall be no more pulled out which I have given them sayeth the Lord. You say wait a minute the Jews are going to be one more time? That's right, but they will be that final time when they will not be pulled out again. The Jews are going to be pulled out again, they are going to have to go hide, and we believe they are going to hide in Petra. In Hosea 3:4 and 5, it says, for the children of Israel shall abide many days without a king, and without a prince, and without a sacrifice, without an image, and without an ephod, and without a teraphim. Afterwards shall the children of Israel turn and seek the Lord their God and David their king, and shall fear the Lord, his goodness in the latter days. You know the Bible tells us that the Jews will come back and be believers. It says they're going to be believers though when they've realized during the tribulation period, they are finally going to realize that the one they pierced is the one that was the Messiah, and they are going to weep and wail because they are going to realize that they could of had prosperity and peace all these years, but because of their own obstinance. You know God gave the Jews tremendous warnings, he said I will bless you of any people and I will curse you above any people. How many of us cannot believe the Bible when we look at the Jews? How do you figure this small percentage of the world's population, and every important position, every place there's the Jews. The greatest scientists the world has ever known have been the Jews. They're just a small little old dot in

the world's population. The Bible says when the second group of the Jews start returning to Israel, watch. Of course we know that we are seeing that right now. Since 1948 and 1949 until this year, there has never been so many Jews, almost 200,000 Russian Jews have gone back to Israel this year.

These tracts are right out here, listen you know you remember me telling you about the toll booth operator that came out to my house and knocked on the door. He said I received hundreds of tracts, and this is the only one that has ever made sense. And he got saved. You know, I go up and I say, listen I'd like to give you something. There is just a lot of nice ways. You know, the tracts, there are many ways you can use them. But if you can just say something to people, and give these out, people will take them and they will read them. And I would take these with you, and I'd keep one that I don't give out, I keep one that you just keep. And I would study it, I'd look up these verses in the Bible because it's all by Grace. One thing that bothers me today is that you will hear people hit around the gospel, hit all around the gospel, but if they don't say it's all by Grace if they don't say it's all by the blood, listen forget it it's not the gospel. But use the Heaven tracts, and say listen there is a little test inside here. Do you like to take tests? No I don't like to well this is one you get to grade yourself. Just a way, just some nice friendly way to use a Heaven tract. Even if you didn't learn the hand gesture, learn to use the Heaven tract. The Heaven tract will do more to help you than anything else. And we need to win people to Christ, we need to take these tracts, and we need to give them out. You say, well I don't know how to do it. Listen, you go through all these verses and you study them and you will be ready to start witnessing. You will be ready to start witnessing and it will be an incredible thing. Something in your hand just helps you. There has been literally I know personally, before I even got this tract, there were over 2 million of them already given out through Florida Bible college. And I agree with what Doc Latham said, if every Baptist church and Bible Church would send one person, we could take care of those 2,000 tribes that haven't had anybody go to them yet. You see it? Anyway get the tracts and give them to your friends and you don't have to be obnoxious about it, be nice and be kind and have them ready.

Introduction

So any way, we want to look at the close right now, the invitation time. In sales or anything else if you don't close the person will never buy. If you are selling something and you don't have a way to close; you know Ronald Reagan's dad was a shoe salesman, and he always had a dream of having his own store and he finally got his own store there in Dixon Illinois and lost it during the depression. But he always said to his son, the close is the only way you will ever make any money. This man didn't make any money because alcohol had destroyed him and he was not able to do that. But without alcohol he would have been able to be very, very successful. But anyway, the same thing in witnessing. If you tell someone about Christ and you never get them to make that decision, you never get them to make that decision, a lot of them won't do it. Not all of them, some of them will still do it, but a lot of them won't do it. So it is extremely important not to try to close before the person understands the plan of salvation. When you feel he or she understands the gospel, then you are ready to ask him or her to trust Christ as Savior, then do so don't wait. You know, some of you are afraid to actually do the most serious part.

Here's What to Do

Okay, now here's what you do. The person that is the witness, the person that is witnessing for Christ can say does what I have been saying make sense to you? Does it make sense? Now hopefully the lost person will say yes it does. Then the witness says, since it makes sense to you wouldn't you like to receive Christ as your Savior right now? The lost person: yes I would like to. The witness: all right, the best you know how, do you really believe that Jesus was Lord and that he paid for all your sins? The lost: yes I do. The witness: I'm glad because you believed that God says it, you have eternal life. Look at this verse first John 5:13, these things have I written onto you that believe on the name of the son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life; and you get them to understand it. Now someone says, well should you have them bow their heads? Well honestly, out in the open, no one in the Bible ever bowed their heads to be saved. Now we have them do it in Church we have them close their eyes, not to be saved, but just to make it a little easier. I am not saying that's wrong, but they cannot think that that is part of being saved. If anything interferes with the gospel of Grace, anything interferes with the gospel of Grace, then we have done away with Grace. If you add anything to it you have done away with it. That is why it is so important to stay on Grace. Now each of these questions you been asking you received yes response, and they say yes I want to receive Christ. Well, do you believe that Christ paid for all your sins? Yes I do. Now if you want to have them bow their heads and close their eyes, you make sure that they understand that that does not save them. You hear me do that every week. You say, is that really that important? Listen if the devil can get anything in the way and make a person to think that they are working their way to Heaven, then the devil has won, and the soul is lost. Salvation is by grace or there is no salvation at all. Now, if any of these points, and they say no I don't understand it, and then you find out what their objections are.

What to Do with Rejection

Now let's say a person just totally refuses to accept Christ, well there's not much you can do. You can't force them to trust Christ. You have to kind of drop it for the time being. But you know, you need to be able to explain to them that they are in a very serious position rejecting Christ who loves them so much. Sometimes now not always but sometimes, I say to back up the hearse. Now what do I mean by back up the hearse? I mean, bring the hearse right to their door. I have done this. I don't always do it but a lot of times I bring up the hearse. Sometimes people, John Fontana witnessed to somebody in the person was just awful to him, mean, ready to just blast him, and said I don't want to hear it. He said well, I appreciate that, he said but let me tell you, if what I'm telling you is true, if you die you are going to go to Hell forever. Now you would think they would just get mad and start, but they usually don't. Now say it the right way, don't say it in a mean way. Don't say like, we heard from DL Moody, one time he got a man to preach and his church, and the man preached on Hell, and everyone liked it. DL said to his wife, Honey, I preach on Hell. She said, yes but you preach on Hell like you want people to go there, and he preaches on Hell like he doesn't want them to go there. Now that is pretty strong and DL Moody never preached that way again. You know, sometimes we can come across like, man we just can't wait to see someone go

there. Go ahead and back up the hearse. Now don't do this with everybody, but let me tell you this. You've just say something like this, I'd rather be in that oven, I'd rather be in that kitchen, than I would be in Hell forever. Man, they don't like that but it is true. I tell you, everybody down deep knows that there is a Hell. Everybody down deep knows there is a Hell. You have heard me said over and over again, that is why people panic, people panic because they know there is a reason they do not want to die. People do not want to talk about it. They just don't want to talk about it. They are afraid of it. Now there are some, there are some, there are a few people on earth that just, now Theodore Roosevelt, I have no signs whatsoever that he was saved, I just finished his book, he wasn't afraid of dying. He said if you are afraid to die you are not worth living. Now that would be a great statement for a Christian but for a non-Christian that's a pretty stupid statement isn't it.

Now another effective way, and we've used this many times and I think you know this, is we use first John 5:10, and when they are not accepting Christ we quote this verse. "He that believeth on the son of God hath the witness in himself; he that believeth not God has made him a liar because he believeth not the record that God gave". Now most people don't want to call God a liar. And you point out that if you believe the record that God gave, you know in first John 5:9, it says if we receive the witness of man, then the witness of God is greater. Now every time we go any grocery store and we pick up anything, we believe the witness of a person. If you receive the witness of a person, you should receive the witness of God. And see, that's why you should be able to see it. You know man will sometimes lie, or sometimes you know, if the person will receive the witness of a man, usually this will sometimes make it clear. Now if a person just out and out does not want it, then the Bible says don't cast your pearls before the swine.

But I will tell you you'll be surprised, so few people are willing to really stand up and say what they really believe. A person that will just stand and say what they truly believe, no matter what no matter how bad it seems to be.

Don't Get These Involved!

Now don't ask a person, now I know not if you would do this, but don't get church membership involved in this, don't ask them to change their life, that's not what we're trying to do. We're trying to get them saved, and they need to be able to see this. Now after that sure it's great for them to see the joy of serving Christ and how wonderful it is to serve Christ. You present the gospel clearly and you also present service clearly you will have people serving Christ. But if they don't present the gospel clearly and then they don't present the service clearly, then you get these poor kids and, listen a person's got to understand that once you're saved you cannot lose it. And you can't have the kids trying to get saved, and the Sunday school teacher. Can you imagine in a church, and all of a sudden a Sunday school teacher of 25 years comes forward and says I've never been saved. Well, maybe some of them haven't but what a terrible tragedy that we never make the gospel clear enough that a Sunday school teacher after 25 years just gets saved, and then all those people say well maybe I'm not saved. And then every Sunday they come forward, and every Sunday they come forward. Now listen, coming forward is not a sin, coming forward is no more wrong than raising your hand. No one raised their hand and the Bible and no one ever came forward in the Bible. I am just telling you you've got to be very careful that you don't confuse people and you don't make them think they're trying to do something and salvation becomes an emotion. And once the salvation becomes an emotion then you do not have salvation. Salvation is not an emotion, salvation is a fact. Salvation is the fact that Jesus Christ died on that Cross and I can believe that and I believe that with my mind. How important that is. Now never tell a person that you have led to Lord that they are saved. Never tell a person that they are saved, you don't know they are saved. Let the word of God tell them that they are saved, let them see it in the word of God. Don't you tell a person that they are saved. Let them

see it; do you see it? Let them see the word of God, let them read the scriptures and let them base their salvation on the word, not on you. Don't you say, well you're saved now. Don't do that, it is a very wrong thing to do and it is a bad thing to do.

(1) Does what I have been saying make sense to you? (2) Would you like to receive Christ right now? (3) Do you believe that Jesus was the Lord and he died to pay for your sins? (4) Look at 1 John 5:13. Since God says it do you believe you have eternal life?

QUESTION 17: True [No one in the Bible ever bowed his or her head to be saved. If you want to have people bow their heads or close their eyes, make sure they understand that does not save them. Salvation does NOT exist apart from grace.]

QUESTION 18: False [You need to be able to explain to them that they are in a very serious position, rejecting Christ, who loves them so much.]

QUESTION 19: *Your answer should be similar to the following:*

It means to tell them that if what you told them is true that they are going to go to hell when they die. They need to know where they will spend eternity when they die.

QUESTION 20: False [Instead, she told him he preached on hell like he wanted people to go there. It's important to communicate the fact without it being in a mean way.]
