Outcome and Support Service: Individualized Home Supports with Training Outcome # 1

NAME: Wyatt Weier

PROGRAM AREA: Social & Adaptive Skills

OUTCOME #1: Wyatt will increase his social and adaptive skills through community participation without prompting from staff.

OUTCOME STATEMENT: By 06/2026, Wyatt will maintain his physical, intellectual, emotional and social functioning through participating in an activity of his choosing in a community setting, as opportunities arise. Wyatt will communicate with Designated Coordinator at least 1 week prior to attending event/activity of his choosing, 100% of opportunities in one month for twelve consecutive months, with unlimited prompts from staff.

PROGRAM RATIONALE: To encourage community participation & identify Wyatt as a valued member of the community.

CHANGES OR MODIFICATIONS NECESSARY TO THE PHYSICAL & SOCIAL ENVIRONMENTS: Community members, staff, and/or family/friends may be present. No modifications are necessary for Wyatt to participate.

EQUIPMENT AND/OR MATERIALS NEEDED: Cell phone, and Designated Coordinator's phone number.

STAFF OR POSITIONS RESPONSIBLE FOR IMPLEMENTATION: Direct Support Staff, Designated Coordinator, Designated Manager, Program Supervisor, Office Manager

LEARNING STYLE: Wyatt learns best using verbal instruction, watching others, and/or environmental cues.

COMMUNICATION MODE: Wyatt understands English and can read, write, and do simple math.

METHODS OR ACTIONS USED TO SUPPORT THE PERSON & TO ACCOMPLISH THE OUTCOME:

1. Wyatt will ask his Designated Coordinator to make an appointment for community activities 1 week prior to appointment.
2. If the Designated Coordinator does not receive a one weeks' notice Wyatt will receive a (-).

DATA COLLECTION METHOD:

1. Recording Key: Wyatt will receive a (+) if he notifies the DC one week prior to activity. Wyatt will receive a (-) if he does not give a one weeks' notice to the DC. Staff should chart the date, (+) or (-) and staff's initials.
2. Location of data sheet: Outcome #1 on Pavillio
3. Schedule/Frequency of data collection: As opportunities arise.

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Outcome and Support Service: Individualized Home Supports with Training Outcome # 2

NAME: Wyatt Weier

PROGRAM AREA: Problem Solving

OUTCOME #2: Wyatt will increase his problem-solving skills.

OUTCOME STATEMENT: By 06/2026, Wyatt will remain calm and work on his problem-solving skills, with 3 verbal prompts from staff 80% of all opportunities in one month for 6 consecutive months.

PROGRAM RATIONALE: To encourage independence and problem-solving skills.

CHANGES OR MODIFICATIONS NECESSARY TO THE PHYSICAL & SOCIAL ENVIRONMENTS: Community members, staff, and/or family/friends may be present. No modifications are necessary for Wyatt to participate.

EQUIPMENT AND/OR MATERIALS NEEDED: Staff, designated coordinator, cell phone, paper, pencil, internet.

STAFF OR POSITIONS RESPONSIBLE FOR IMPLEMENTATION: Direct Support Staff, Designated Coordinator, Designated Manager, Program Supervisor, Office Manager

LEARNING STYLE: Wyatt learns best using verbal instruction, watching others, and/or environmental cues.

COMMUNICATION MODE: Wyatt understands English and can read, write, and do simple math.

METHODS OR ACTIONS USED TO SUPPORT THE PERSON & TO ACCOMPLISH THE OUTCOME:

1. When a problem arises Wyatt will remain calm and try to independently work through it.
2. If Wyatt is unable to work through the problem by himself, he will seek help from his staff, or DC and continue to remain calm.
3. If staff or DC are unable to help fix the problem, they will assist Wyatt with reaching out to another source depending on the situation.

DATA COLLECTION METHOD:

1. Recording Key: Wyatt will receive a (Yes) if he is able to remain calm and work through his problem with 3 or less prompts. Wyatt will receive a (No) if he needs 4 or more prompts to remain calm and work through his problem. Staff should chart the date, (yes) or (no) and the problem Wyatt worked through along with how many prompts he needed.
2. Location of data sheet: Outcome #2 on Pavillio
3. Schedule/Frequency of data collection: As opportunities arise.
