Pediatric ATI Remediation

Hematologic Disorders: Immunizations for a Client Who Has Sickle Cell Anemia (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 21 Hematologic Disorders,Active Learning Template: Basic Concept)

- Maintain up to-to-date immunizations
- Administer opioids on a regular schedule to maintain control, or prevent pain if possible
- Administer hydroxyurea by mouth to help increase oxygenation in the cells

Pediatric Emergencies: Caring for a School-Age Child Who Is Experiencing Anaphylaxis (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 43 Pediatric Emergencies,Active Learning Template: System Disorder)

- Follow the American Heart Association guidelines for CPR for respiratory and cardiac arrest
- Administer oxygen as prescribed
- Position to maintain patent airway and monitor respiratory status and monitor vital signs

Epidemiology and Communicable Diseases: Nationally Notifiable Sexually Transmitted Infections (RM CH RN 8.0 Chp 3 Epidemiology and Communicable Disease,Active Learning Template: System Disorder)

- HIV
- Herpes Simplex Virus
- Chlamydia

Health Promotion of Infants (2 Days to 1 Year): Teaching About Home Safety (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 3 Health Promotion of Infants (2 Days to 1 Year),Active Learning Template: Growth and Development)

- Hot water thermostats should be set at or below 120°F
- Sharp objects should be kept out of reach
- Secure fencing around swimming pools

Acute Neurologic Disorders: Indications to Discontinue Droplet Precautions (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 12 Acute Neurological Disorders,Active Learning Template: System Disorder)

- When the patient is no longer contagious
- Have the client in a private room for droplet precautions
- Providers and visitors should wear a mask

Safe Administration of Medication: Restraining Methods for an Infant (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 8 Safe Administration of Medication,Active Learning Template: Nursing Skill)

- Mitten Restraints
- Therapeutic Holding
- Elbow Restraints

Health Promotion of Toddlers (1 to 3 Years): Reportable Findings (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 4 Health Promotion of Toddlers (1 to 3 Years),Active Learning Template: Growth and Development)

- Report to the provider if the child can say one-word sentences by two
- Report to the provider if the child cannot build a tower of two block by 15 months
- Report to the provider if the child cannot walk up and down the stairs by placing both feet on each step

Psychosocial Issues of Infants, Children, and Adolescents: Planning Care for a Child Who Has Autism Spectrum Disorder (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 44 Psychosocial Issues of Infants, Children, and Adolescents,Active Learning Template: System Disorder)

- Monitor for behavior changes
- Refer to early intervention, physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech and language therapy
- Decrease environmental stimulation

Death and Dying: Age-Appropriate Response to Death (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 11 Death and Dying,Active Learning Template: Growth and Development)

- Infants and toddlers have little to no concept of death
- Preschool children view dying as temporary because of a concept of time and because the dead person can still have attributes of the living
- School-age children begin to have an adult concept of death

Cognitive and Sensory Impairments: Facilitating Communication With a Child Who Has Hearing Loss (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 15 Cognitive and Sensory Impairments,Active Learning Template: Basic Concept)

- Promote speech development, lip reading, and use of cued speech
- Use sign language or an interpreter if appropriate when working with a child who has hearing loss
- Assist with the use of hearing aids

Bowel Elimination: Evaluating Teaching About Encopresis (RM Fund 10.0 Chp 43 Bowel Elimination,Active Learning Template: System Disorder)

- Encopresis is the leaking of stool from the rectum
- With encopresis there can be some abdominal pain
- There will be hard stools with encopresis

Complications of Infants: Teaching About Meal Planning for a Toddler Who Has Phenylketonuria (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 42 Complications of Infants,Active Learning Template: System Disorder)

- Place the patient on a formula low in phenylalanine
- Fruits

- Vegetables

Immunizations: Contraindication for Receiving the Measles, Mumps, and Rubella Vaccine (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 35 Immunizations,Active Learning Template: Medication)

- Severely immunosuppressed
- Sever febrile illness
- Common cold

Intravenous Therapy: Planning Antibiotic Therapy for an Infant (RM Fund 10.0 Chp 49 Intravenous Therapy,Active Learning Template: Nursing Skill)

- Check the prescription
- Identify allergies to latex or tape
- Follow the rights of medication administration

Miscellaneous Pain Medications: Preparing to Apply Lidocaine and Prilocaine Cream (RM Pharm RN 8.0 Chp 38 Miscellaneous Pain Medications, RM Pharm RN 8.0 Chp 38 Miscellaneous Pain Medications v2,Active Learning Template: Medication)

- Apply to intact skin 1hr before routine procedures or superficial punctures
- Apply to the smallest surface area needed to minimize systemic absorption
- Prior to procedure, remove the dressing and clean the skin with aseptic solution

Health Promotion of Preschoolers (3 to 6 years): Assessing for Lead Poisoning (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 5 Health Promotion of Preschoolers (3 to 6 Years),Active Learning Template: System Disorder)

- Use a blood lead test for screening
- It is important to identify the asymptomatic patients
- Care for the patient with elevated lead levels as quickly as possible

Musculoskeletal Congenital Disorders: Caring for an Infant Who Requires a Pavlik Harness (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 28 Musculoskeletal Congenital Disorders,Active Learning Template: Therapeutic Procedure)

- Maintain harness placement for up to 12 weeks
- Check straps every 1-2 weeks for adjustment
- Perform neurovascular and skin integrity checks

Hematologic Disorders: Planning Care for a Child Who is Experiencing Sickle Cell Crisis (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 21 Hematologic Disorders,Active Learning Template: System Disorder)

- Promote rest to decrease oxygen consumption
- Administer oxygen as prescribed if hypoxia is present
- Monitor and report laboratory results

Cardiovascular Disorders: Identifying the Location of a Patent Ductus Arteriosus (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 20 Cardiovascular Disorders,Active Learning Template: System Disorder)

- Condition in which the normal fetal circulation conduit between the pulmonary artery and the aorta fails to close and results in increased pulmonary blood flow
- Symptoms include wide pulse pressure
- Symptoms include heart failure and rales

HIV/AIDS: Evaluating Parent Understanding (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 38 HIV/AIDS,Active Learning Template: System Disorder)

- The parent should be able to perform safe practice when using needles/syringes and administering medications
- The parents should understand that the illness is chronic and there is a need for lifelong medication administration
- The parents should understand when to notify the provider if they experience such manifestations like headaches, fever, lethargy, warmth, tenderness, redness at joints, and neck stiffness

Pediatric Emergencies: Priority Action for Submersion Injury (RM NCC RN 11.0 Chp 43 Pediatric Emergencies,Active Learning Template: System Disorder)

- Monitor the patient's respiratory status
- Administer emergency medications as prescribed
- Prepare for intubation if needed

Cancer Disorders: Manifestations of Hodgkin's Lymphoma (RM AMS RN 11.0 Chp 92 Cancer Disorders,Active Learning Template: System Disorders)

- Enlarged lymph nodes
- Night sweats
- Unplanned weight loss
