

Psychosocial Integrity

- Substance Use and Other Disorders and Dependencies
 - Abstinence syndrome occurs when someone suddenly quits taking a medication from which they were physically dependent.
 - Benzodiazepines, like lorazepam, are used for alcohol withdraw.
 - Disulfiram is used for alcohol abstinence succeeding withdraw.

Pharmacological and Parenteral Therapies

- Adverse Effects/Contraindications/Side Effects/Interactions
 - Morphine can cause respiratory depression and can negatively interact with alcohol and other CNS depressants.
 - Warfarin can cause hemorrhaging and is contraindicated with an elevated PTT.
 - Digoxin can cause cardiac dysrhythmias.
- Expected Actions/Outcomes
 - Propranolol's expected outcome is a reduction in blood pressure.
 - Bethanechol chloride's expected outcome is to reduce urinary retention.
 - Donepezil is supposed to slow the progression of memory loss.
- Medication Administration
 - The patient's name and birthday must be verified before medication administration.
 - Patients have the right to refuse medication.
 - Explanations of the reasoning for medications is a right to a patient.
- Parenteral/Intravenous Therapies
 - Infiltration presents itself as cool, blanching, and edematous.
 - The size of the needle is inversely proportional to the number of the gauge.
 - IM injections need to be conducted at a 90-degree angle.
- Pharmacological Pain Management
 - The numerical scale helps the nurse determine the intensity of a patient's pain.
 - Pain is subjective and must be treated.
 - NSAIDs, opioids, and non-opioid analgesics can be used for pain.
