You go east on Fairchild to Bowman Avenue and then turn north (left). Bowman curves to the right just before you come to the shopping mall area. There is plenty of parking in front of the building.

As always, you will be in uniform and have your badge and masks. When you arrive, you will check in at the front desk and then will be directed to the appropriate office.

Complete this Active Learning activity after your clinical at the Women’s Care Clinic. Submit your completed assignment to the dropbox within 5 days of this clinical rotation. **Be sure you look at the attached rubric as you write up this assignment because it must be written with accurate grammar and spelling as well as APA format for references.** Your score will be based on this rubric. You must receive 77% in order to pass this clinical assignment.

### **1. How many clients were seen today at the clinic?**

- Today there were eight clients scheduled to be seen at the Women’s Care Clinic.

### **2. What were the activities that the Social worker and the nurse performed today?**

- The social worker did not have any in person appointments at the time that the student was there. The nurse did two pregnancy test and one ultrasound. The pregnancy test is done by urine and the results come back in three minutes on the test strip. A transvaginal ultrasound was completed on a client who was six weeks pregnant.

### **3. How were you an engaged nursing professional today?**

- Today I was able to ask many questions about the Women’s Care Clinic and everything they do. They had many topics to cover to provide me with as much information as possible about their clinic. It was educational to hear the types of questions that the clients are asked by the nurse as well.

### **4. How did you contribute to the service provided by the clinic nurse today?**

- The clinic nurse performed the pregnancy test and ultrasound, but I was able to help her clean up after each patient as well as prepare for the next.

### **5. What are the health risks of the population served during today’s clinical based on your observations today?**

- There were multiple things that have been observed today that could be health risks for these clients. Some of them admitted to smoking weed, cigarettes, and vaping while pregnant. There were others who admitted to drinking as well. These clients were politely educated on how those things can affect the baby and were given a pamphlet on all the risks.

### **6. How does this clinical site relate to the Population and Global Health Course?**

- The Women’s Care Clinic related to this course because they help the women and men in the community at no cost. They mentioned that they are publicly funded and hold fundraisers twice a year. The clients that go to the clinic are provided with educational material, insurance assistance, and are offered to be set up with a therapist if needed. The clinic has a bridge program that

involves the clients going to classes, reading the bible, making appointments, and more. If the clients accomplish those tasks, they get points and the points allow them to shop for things such as diapers, clothing for mom and baby, strollers, cribs, and more.

**7. Name 3 ways this clinical site impacts Population and Global health?**

- The Women's Care Clinic impacts population and Global health because they are improving the health of the community. The clinic has many programs and resources to ensure people have what they need to raise their child and keep them healthy. The clinic also allows fathers to attend classes to assist them in court when having custody issues. There are many young women that come into the clinic that are pregnant which can affect their mental health; therefore, it is important that they offer referrals for therapy.

**8. Choose one of the health risks identified in question 6 and develop a plan of care to address this. Include a Nursing diagnosis, a measurable goal, and at least 3 Nursing interventions to achieve this goal.**

**Nursing Diagnosis:**

- Deficient knowledge related to use of marijuana as evidence by continuing despite of complications.

**Goals:**

- Client will identify/initiate necessary lifestyle changes to remain drug-free with optimal pregnancy outcome (Bose et al., 2021).
- Client will recognize health problems as they arise and initiate steps to resolve (Bose et al., 2021).

**Nursing Intervention:**

- Assess client's knowledge of own condition
- Provide information about the maternal and fetal effects of drugs.
- Discuss the relationship of drug use to current situation/pregnancy.
- Provide information regarding available organizations and programs for assistance/referral.

**9. How will your experience during the Women's Care Clinic job shadowing impact your Nursing practice?**

- The experience from the Women's Care Clinic will impact my nursing practice because it has opened my eyes on the type of problems clients may be facing and how to assist them as their nurse. It is special to see programs like this one and witness how they help people who need it and may be going through a hard time.

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
