A group of students from Lakeview College of Nursing will participate in supporting the most vulnerable homeless on their journey of healing and restoration at C-U at home in Champaign, IL **on** October 28, 2021, **from** 12pm-5pm. The public is invited to attend us in supporting the homeless, creating long lasting relationships, and breaking down the barriers put up by society.

This event will be held at 70 E Washington St, Champaign, IL 61820. You can expect to take a tour of the C-U at home building and watch a short presentation of what they do for the community. They provide a men's sober shelter, C-U at Austin's place sober women's shelter, C-U at work, Phoenix drop-in center, transitional housing, transportation ministry, street outreach, education, and advocacy. There will be opportunity at the phoenix drop-in center to have conversations and create relationships with the homeless. There will be many games that can be played to interact with each other. Make sure to bring a mask as C-U at home follows strict guidelines to ensure everyone remains healthy. Register to participate in this event by October 27, 2021, by 5pm.
