This standard consists of a nursing process that includes assessment, diagnosis, outcomes identification, planning, implementation, evaluation (Marquis & Huston, 2021). This concept has also been used in every care plan we did for clinical and case studies in different classes. Another concept that was easily mastered was the sentinel event. This concept was defined as an event, incident, or condition that results in death, permanent harm, or severe, temporary harm to a patient that needs an immediate investigation and response (Marquis & Huston 2021). This concept also helps in improving the health care system, patient safety, and preventing any further harm.
