

Management of Care

- Give a patient zofran if they are feeling nauseous
- When taking a telephone prescription read it back to the provider
- When taking a telephone prescription ask the Dr. to spell prescriptions out to make sure you have the right one

Safety and Infection Control

- Reduce medication errors by checking with the MAR
- Use a N95 when around patients with TB
- Performing hand hygiene before and after seeing a patient

Health Promotion and Maintenance

- Teaching appropriate techniques for aging clients
- Talking a client with dementia through the bathing process
- Knowing how to accurately take a client's blood pressure

Psychosocial Integrity

- Knowing how to talk with a client with a terminal illness
- Knowing of to perform end of life care for the patient and the family
- Knowing the dying process

Basic Care and Comfort

- Showing a client how to use their walker
- Knowing how to prevent skin breakdown on a client
- Knowing the signs of sleep deprivation in clients

Pharmacological and Parenteral Therapies

- Teaching a client how to self administer ophthalmic solutions
- Teaching self administration for suppositories
- Knowing the rights of medication to prevent medication errors

Reduction of Risk Potential

- Knowing how to palpate for a systolic blood pressure
- Knowing what actions to take during fluid overload
- When the right time is to select a coude catheter

Physiological Adaptation

- Knowing how to care for pressure injuries
- Knowing how to perform dressing changes
- Knowing manifestations of Cheyne - stokes respirations
