Management of Care:

- Develop a better understanding of the priority for assessment purposes.
- Understand that certain findings warrant further assessment.
- Develop a key understanding of the common medical conditions involving mother and baby.

Safety and Infection Control:

- Understand the assessment of newborns and the potential complications that can come with that such as a newborn with abstinence syndrome.
- Plan discharge teaching for the new parents involving care seat safety.
- Understanding the proper hygiene for caring for a newborn post-delivery before their first bath.

Health Promotion and Maintenance:

- Develop a clear understanding of prenatal care in terms of auscultating fetal heart rate.
- Understand all of the expected changes and warning signs for each trimester.
- Learn about all the risk factors for pelvic inflammatory disease or any other infections and how to prevent them.

Psychosocial Integrity:

- Understand and manage the assessment of newborn complications.
- Be aware of the possible implications that substance abuse can cause to a newborn.
- Develop a better understanding of neonatal abstinence syndrome.

Basic Care and Comfort:

- Develop a proper understanding of pain management during labor and delivery.
- Understand that there are multiple forms of pain management including hypnosis.
- Be aware of the different sources of nutrients and teaching the client about high-calcium foods.

Pharmacological and Parental Therapies:

- Develop a proper understanding of the adverse effects and interactions for Clomiphene Citrate and Magnesium Sulfate.
- Learn how to administer Dexamethasone.
- Understanding different infections such as the Herpes Simplex Virus type 2.

Reduction of Risk Potential:

- Be aware of potential newborn complications and when to report to the provider.
- Identifying laboratory findings for a client with Preeclampsia.
- Understanding the assessment of newborns post term.

Physiological Adaptation:

- Understanding how to care for a newborn who has Necrotizing enterocolitis.
- Develop an understanding of the different types of STI's and how to plan care for those patients.
- Learn and master the proper things to look out for in regards to the baby's vitals during labor such as late decelerations.
