SAMPLE Topic: Anemias: Discharge Teaching for a Client Who is Recovering from Sickle Cell Crisis <ul style="list-style-type: none">• SAMPLE Critical Point #1: Anemia is the abnormally low amount of circulation RB, Hgb concentration, or both.• SAMPLE Critical Point #2: When a patient is going through sickle crisis, the nurse should monitor oxygen saturation to determine a need for oxygen therapy.• SAMPLE Critical Point #3: A patient should have their hemoglobin checking in 4 to 6 weeks to determine efficacy.

- **Dizziness**

- Stop the transfusion immediately
- Activate emergency procedures
- Check/monitor patients' vitals

- **Acute respiratory distress**
- **Tachycardia**
- **Acute pulmonary edema**

Topic: Rheumatoid Arthritis: Findings to Report

- **Fever**
- **Weight loss**
- **Stiffness or swelling in more than one joint**

Topic: Connective Tissue Disorders: Pain Medication for Fibromyalgia

- Duloxetine (Cymbalta)
- Milnacipran (Savella)
- Pregabain (Lyrica)

Topic: Nonopioid Analgesics: Pain Medication for a Client Who Has Cholelithiasis

- **Diclofenac**
- **Ketorolac**
- **Flurbiprofen**

Topic: Coagulation Disorders: Expected Laboratory Test for a Client Who Has Petechiae and Ecchymoses

- **PT Prothrombin**
- **Evaluates the ability form blood clots**
- **Used to diagnose bleeding disorders.**

Subcategory: Health Promotion/Disease Prevention

Topic: Infections of the Renal and Urinary System: Planning Care for a Female Client Who Has Recurrent Urinary Tract Infections

- Assess the symptoms of a UTI
- Encourage patients to drink fluids
- Administer antibiotic as ordered
- Encourage patient to void frequently

Topic: Nutrition During Pregnancy: Preventing Neural Tube Defects

- **Consume Folic acid daily**
- **Manage preexisting health conditions before pregnancy**
- **Avoid getting overheated or having a fever during pregnancy**

Topic: Health Promotion of Toddlers (1 to 3 years): Assessing Developmental Milestones

- **Walking**
- **Kicking**
- **Running**

Subcategory: Health Screening

Topic: Health Promotion of Infants (2 Days to 1 Year): Finding to Report

- By the age of 12 months the infants birth weight should have tripled
- Open fontenels
- Birth length less than 50%

Topic: Osteoporosis: Dietary Recommendations for Health Promotion

- **Dark leafy greens such as kale and spinach**
- **Mustard Greens**
- **Calcium and Vitamin D**

Topic: Safe Administration of Medication: Administering Eye Drops to a School-Age Child

- **Place the child in supine or sitting position**
- **Extend head and ask the child to look up**
- **Pull the lower lid downward and apply medication in the pocket**
- **Add ointments before nap time**

Subcategory: Techniques and Physical Assessment

Topic: Physical Assessment Findings: Preparing to Assess a 2- week old newborn

- Head circumference slightly exceeds the chest
- Changes in skin color
- Malformations

Topic: Heart Failure and Pulmonary Edema: Priority Action for Fluid Overload

- **Give oxygen to the patient**

- **Use a nasal canula**
- **Maintain adequate blood pressure.**

- Level of consciousness
- Personality Change
- Restlessness and agitation, Sundowning can occur

- **Anxiety and depressive disorders**
- **Decreased in current activities**
- **Guilt, negative beliefs and cognitive distortions**

Topic: Group and Family Therapy: Identifying Characteristics of a Therapeutic Group

- **Altruism**
- **Imitative behavior**
- **Individual learning**

Subcategory: Substance Use and Other Disorders and Dependencies

Topic: Medications for Substance Use Disorders: Prescription for Nicotine Addiction

- Bupropion
- Varenicline
- Wellbutrin

Topic: Sensory Perception: Caring for a Client Who Has Vision Loss

- **Do not push or pull the patient**
- **Do not hold on to the patients arm**
- **Walk at a relaxed comfortable pace**

Topic: Urinary Elimination: Bladder Retraining for Urge Incontinence

- **Start by holding urine for 5 minutes when feeling the urge to urinate**
- **When its easy to wait 5 minutes try to increase to 10 minutes**
- **Continue to increase until urinating every 3 to 4 hours.**
