Expected findings of personality disorder

Indexability/ maladaptive response to stress

Lack of restraint

Tendency to promote interpersonal conflict

Health Promotion and Maintenance-

Delirium causes- lack of sleep, illness, and pain, in older adults often caused by UTI Temporary usually

Dementia – unknown cause, is progressive over time and permanent

Interviewing clients includes standard technique and therapeutic communication. The nurses while assessing physical form should also be mindful of the building of the therapeutic relationship.

Psychosocial Integrity-

Disorders that can occur or manifest during adolescents

- Eating disorders
- Anxiety
- Depressive
- Conduct

Crisis intervention

- Asses for violence or safety issues
- Identity crisis
- Use crisis interventions to help the client during issues

Crisis characteristics

- Unexpected or sudden event with little time to prepare
- Perception that event is overwhelming
- Loss of or decrease in communication with support system
- Sense of displacement
- Perceived loss

Pharmacological and Parenteral Therapies-

Antidepressants are categorized in 5 groups

- TCAs
- SSRIs
- SNRIs
- MAOIs

Trilithic antidepressants side effects

Postural hypotension

Anticholinergic effects

B/P changes

Schizophrenia medication

First gens, second gens, and third gens are used to treat positive and negative symptoms respectively.

Reduction of Risk Potential-

MAOIs are contraindicated for those taking SSRIs

Hypertensive crisis- dietary tyramine

Nurse needs to watch for

- Headache
- High BP
- Vomiting
- Diparesis
