<p>Level of motivation for learning: Patient and wife want to get him back home as soon as possible.</p> <p>Barriers to effective learning: Patient is a older male in his eighties, wife seem older as well that can have an effect on the material being learned.</p> <p>Health beliefs/values: Patient wants to get better and get back home to enjoy life</p> <p>Psychosocial development: Adult level</p> <p>Cognitive development: Formal Operational</p>	<p>Nursing Diagnosis: Risk for falls related to hip fracture evidenced by patient not being able to withstand any pressure on leg</p> <p>Goal of Teaching: The goal of teaching is to get the patient to understand how maneuver as a fall risk after surgery</p>	<p>Intervention 1: Maintain bed rest or limb rest as indicated. Provide support of joints above and below the fracture site, especially when moving and turning (Swearingen & Wright, 2019). This will help the patient and family decreases fall risk.</p> <p>Intervention 2: Support fracture site with pillows or folded blankets (Swearingen & Wright, 2019). This will help keep pain down and decrease movement.</p> <p>Intervention 3: Use sufficient personnel when turning (Emmerson et al., 2020). Having someone there to help turning and adjusting the patient will decrease accidents and fall risk.</p>	<p>Method 1: Discussion method.</p> <p>Method 2: Interacted with the Patient and wife answering questions about the information.</p>	<p>Discuss how the client/family received the teaching: Family received the teachings well; they are looking forward to doing rehab.</p> <p>Identify strengths/weaknesses of the client or family in receiving teaching: Strengths were that the wife was there asking questions about information. Weakness is I was not able to give the wife a lot more information on other interventions.</p> <p>Suggest modifications to improve teaching plan (what would have improved the plan?): Having more sources for different interventions, if possible, having the son there to have another support person to help learn</p>
