Tools: Yes, it's important to assess if the client is still having suicidal ideation active and passive thoughts. MSE: Was your patient still expressing ideation at the time of the assessment? If not, you would not choose this option. If yes, in the comments I would state active or passive. Explore if there is a plan.

Reflection: I could see where it would be difficult to talk to someone in an open area. There are some patients who would not open up to you if they felt uncomfortable or even judged by others present. You should review the chart to better understand the medication, treatment plan, and psychiatric history if you are able to. Sometimes, reviewing past stays, family history, and other pertinent information can help nursing staff with the care they provide. Great job!
