Another motivation factor was that the client used to be an LPN and understands the benefit of teaching for the student nurse and the client.</p> <p>Barriers to effective learning: I did not observe any barriers that the client was presenting. The client having a history of not being compliant could possibly mean that she will still refuse to follow adequate treatment. The client uses assistive devices and gets tired and out of breath during daily activities. This could limit her motivation for seeking help and staying up to date with appointments and therapy.</p> <p>Health beliefs/values: The client believes that she</p>	<p><b>Nursing Diagnosis:</b></p> <p>Ineffective self-care maintenance related to acute exacerbation of COPD as evidenced by not being compliant in managing her COPD and underlying medical conditions (Wagner, 2022).</p> <p><b>Goal of Teaching:</b> Teach the client what increases the risk of her exacerbation of COPD, associated factors and adverse effects of not being compliant, and lifestyle changes that the client is suggested to make. The most important goal is to get the client to participate in her treatment plan.</p>	<p><b>Intervention 1:</b> Encourage participation in care to prevent dependency on health care team.</p> <p><b>Intervention 2:</b> Create short-term goals while the client is hospitalized. An example of a short-term goal would be using a respiratory device that loosens mucus and secretions for at least 2-4 times a day, 15 minutes each time (Wagner, 2022).</p> <p><b>Intervention 3:</b> Physical therapy. The physical therapist must stress the importance of getting the client back to a state where she feels capable of living day-to-day life with her medical condition of COPD (Phelps,</p>	<p><b>Method 1:</b> Discussion: The client has had COPD for most of her life. She was eager to discuss the material presented with her personal experience.</p> <p><b>Method 2:</b> Q&amp;A: As I was providing teaching, I was asking the client questions to determine if the COPD material was accurate and relatable to the client's experience.</p>	<p>Discuss how the client/family received the teaching: The client received the teaching in her bed. She was relaxed and open to communication. The client was in no distress and provided additional information about her inhalers and incentive spirometer devices she has used throughout her history with COPD.</p> <p>Identify strengths/weaknesses of the client or family in receiving teaching:</p> <p>Strengths: The client demonstrated active listening skills and participated in the discussion and Q&amp;A.
