

The oral solution should be used within 3 months if stored by patient at 25°C (77° F), excursions permitted to 15-30° C (59-86° F).
Keep container tightly closed.




(Review the MAR and medication label. Measure the correct dose of the medication by dragging the syringe. Then click "Submit.")


