

## N433 – Active Learning for NICU Shadowing Experience

### **1. How did you contribute to the service provided by the NICU nurse today?**

I contributed to the service provided for the NICU patient by being actively present and doing everything the NICU nurse did to ensure that the patient received the care she needed and that her vital signs and labs stayed within normal limits. I helped change the bed linens, which were changed once a week. I assisted with cluster care while the infant was receiving an X-ray. We monitored the vitals closely and read the oxygen level continuously as it would get below 70%. I also provided care by assisting the parents in holding their babies so they could achieve their skin-to-skin goal.

### **2. What are the health risks of the population served during today's clinical based on your observations today?**

There are many health risks to this population. Because the infant was a micro preemie, she was at even greater risk for certain things. The highest health risk is morbidity. Morbidity is the most significant health risk that this population faces. The other major health risks are infection. Their organs are not developed fully, which puts them at a higher risk of infection (Kauffman, 2023). They may face feeding intolerance along with aspiration from the underdeveloped GI tract. Development delays will also be a health risk because these micro-preemies are so premature, but this will not show until the baby grows. It is essential to educate the parents about these health risks.

**3. Choose one of the health risks identified in the above question and develop a plan of care to address this. Include a nursing diagnosis, a measurable goal (SMART), and at least three nursing interventions to achieve this goal.**

- a. **Nursing diagnosis:** At risk for infection related to the immune system as evidenced by the WBC being at 25 ( $4.5$  to  $11.0 \times 10^9/L$ ).
- b. **Measurable Goal:** The infant's measurable goal would be for the white blood cell (WBC) count level to go down. The level is at 25 ( $4.5$  to  $11.0 \times 10^9/L$ ). The goal would be to get the level down to 18 after the antibiotics are completed.
- c. **Intervention 1:** The first intervention would be administering antibiotics as prescribed to help fight the infection.
- d. **Intervention 2:** The second intervention would be to provide a clean environment. This includes doing adequate hand hygiene.
- e. **Intervention 3:** Monitor the patient's temperature every hour and monitor labs like the WBC to see if there is an infection currently.

**4. How will your experience during the NICU shadowing impact your nursing practice?**

The NICU shadow experience will impact my nursing practice by providing me with a different type of education. I am used to patients who can verbally tell me what is wrong or a family member telling me what happened to cause an issue. For example, if I were to pursue a career in the ER, I would need to know and understand the different ranges of vital signs and labs for each age group. The NICU showed that in certain circumstances, you must also provide education and care to the family. In this case, it was the infant's parents. It showed me that involving the parents will, in return, be beneficial to this infant's health and recovery. This will impact my nursing career by believing that emotional and mental wellness can help heal the body.
